The meeting of 213rd State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) was held on 01/06/2018 at the Directorate of Environment. The following were present in the meeting:-

The minutes of 339th SEAC meeting dated 18/05/2018 as per the agenda was discussed in the meeting. The following decisions were taken –

1. Baluwa Bhawani Bux Ordinary Sand Mining Project in Ghaghra River at Gata No.-2 Mi, Village- Baluwa Bhawani Bux, Tehsil- Sagri, District.-Azamgarh,U.P., M/s Aditya Singh,(Leased Area:5.810 ha), File No. 4263/Proposal No. (SIA/UP/ MIN /74772/2018)


The SEIAA noted that the project proponent has requested to defer the matter to next meeting. SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to defer the matter

2. Ordinary Sand Mining Project in Yamuna River at Gata No.-2 Mi, Village- Madanpur, Tehsil- Etmadpur, District-Agra, U.P., Shri Amandeep Singh, Leased Area:7.28 Ha, File No. 4264/Proposal No. (SIA/UP/ MIN /74773/2018)

The SEIAA gone through the recommendation of SEAC to grant Environment clearance with general & specific conditions. SEIAA also gone through the file and documents and found that in LOI dated 25-01-2018 the mineable reserve has been mentioned as 145600 m³/year whereas in the minutes of SEAC total mineable reserve according to LOI has been mentioned as 64500 m³/year under the project details. In Form-1 mineable reserve has been mentioned as 145600m³ while in the revised Form-1 submitted by project proponent mineable reserve has been mentioned as 64500m³ which is said to be as per LOI. No revised LOI has been submitted. Hence, SEIAA is of the opinion that the project proponent should clarify the matter and submit revised LOI/necessary documents from the competent authority in this regard.







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3. Proposed Ordinary Sand Mining at Yamuna River at Gata No.-1/2, Village- Chaprauli Khadar, Tehsil- Badaut, District-Baghat, U.P., M/s Apollo Retailers Pvt. Ltd., (Leased Area:20.2343 Ha), File No. 4266/Proposal No. (SIA/UP/ MIN /74791/2018)

The SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific conditions no-2 of annexure-2 as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 25 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate.

The SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific conditions no-2 of annexure-2 as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 25 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate and added condition- "This clearance shall be subject to direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Taj Trapezium Authority".

The SEIAA gone through the recommendation of SEAC to grant Environment clearance with general & specific conditions. SEIAA also gone through the file and documents and noted that mineable reserve and total production has been mentioned as 145728 m³/year under the details of the project in SEAC minutes. SEIAA also noted that in LOI mineable reserve has been mentioned as 145728 m³/year whereas in revised form-1 mineable reserve has been mentioned as 94947 m³/year. Hence, SEIAA is of the opinion that clarification should be submitted by the project proponent for consideration along with the supporting document from the competent authority in this regard.

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6. Proposed River bed Sand Mining in Yamuna River at Zone No./Gata No./Khand No.-168 (Block No.-05), Area-10.0 Ha (24.70 Acres) Village- Sabadakhadar, Tehsil-Pailani, District-Banda. Smt. Poornima Verma, (Leased Area-10.0 Ha), File No. 4269/Proposal No. (SIA/UP/ MIN /74802/2018)

The SEIAA gone through the recommendation of SEAC to grant Environment clearance with general & specific conditions. SEIAA also gone through the file and documents and found that in DSR khand no- 168 (Block no- 5) is not there. Hence, clarification should be submitted by the project proponent at SEIAA for consideration regarding the above along with the supporting document from the competent authority. Cluster certificate should also be amended accordingly.


The SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposals for conducting EIA studies.

The SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposals for conducting EIA studies.

18. Proposed river bed Sand Mining from Yamuna River at Khand No. 11, Village-Kanjasa, Tehsil-Bara, District-Allahabad, U.P. (Leased Area-8.0 Ha) File No. 3984/Proposal No. (SIA/UP/ MIN / 72245/2018)

The SEIAA gone through the recommendation of SEAC and found that EC in the matter was issued by SEIAA through letter no- 172/parya/SEAC/3984/2018 dated 12-02-2018 SEAC has recommended to change the production capacity mentioned in EC dated 12/02/2018







no clarification/basis has been given to change the production capacity. Hence, the matter is referred back to SEAC to mention the reason for permitting change in production with its clear recommendation.

19. Chandwari Ghurouli Sand/ Morrum Mine on Betwa River at Khand No.-26/2, Village- Chandwari Ghurouli, Tehsil- Sarila, District- Hamirpur, U.P., M/s Sarc Infracon India Ltd., Lease Area: 24.291 ha File No. 4247/Proposal No. (SIA/UP/ MIN / 74655/2018)

The SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific conditions no-2 of annexure-2 as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 25 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. The SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC that the project proponent is to be asked to submit information regarding the matter as suggested by the SEAC.




1. Proposed Expansion of Group Housing Plan "Rangjee Heights" at Khasra No.-210, 215, 216, 217, 227, 228, 229, 230, 231 & Part of 209, 232, 233, 234, 235, of Mauza Gailana, Agara, Village- Gailana, Tehsil- Agra, District- Agra. Shri Krishnanand Yadav, File No. 4099//Proposal No. (SIA/UP/NCP/73115/2018)

The SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 26-05-2018 wherein it had asked the project proponent to submit compliance status of existing building viz consent to establish and consent to operate from UPPCB; NOC from TTZ authority, ADA and other related Departments documents by the competent authority. The project proponent has submitted the reply vide letter dated 30-05-2018. The SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC meeting dated 15/05/2018 to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC except that condition 22 which be replaced as "Generator sets to be used as backup power supply should be only be gas based. Under no circumstances diesel generators sets shall not be used for any purpose".


In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 2- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their

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- maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CSR activities along with cost and other details. CSR activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CSR activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
 - 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
 - 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
 - 6- The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum reused for gardening, flushing system etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function.
 - 7- The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
 - 8- NOC from Taj Trapezium Zone authority shall be taken before starting any development work/Construction work on the site. This clearance shall be subject to direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Taj Trapezium Zone Authority in the matter of location of industries and allocation of gas in the Taj Trapezium Zone Authority.
 - 9- The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, Toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CSR fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
