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The Authority after detailed discussion and deliberation decided the following:

1. **Serial No.:1 to 5:** The previous SEIAA (5<sup>th</sup> SEIAA) considered these proposals in 5.116<sup>th</sup> and 5.126<sup>th</sup> meetings held on 21.03.2024 & 11.06.2024, respectively, and decided to close and delist these cases.  
6<sup>th</sup> SEIAA observed that the letters to close and delist these proposals have not been uploaded on the Parivesh Portal 1.0, till date. Therefore, the Authority decided to **upload the close & delist letters** online on Parivesh portal 1.0 for disposal of these cases.
2. **Serial No.:6:** The SEAC-1 considered this proposal in its 5A.188<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 01<sup>st</sup> October 2024, as a case of violation of EIA Notification, 2006. The Authority decided that the final decision of the proposal may be taken after final outcome of WP(c) no 1394/2023 or guidelines issued by MoEF& CC for the cases of EC violation and decided to **close and delist** the proposal. The Authority further decided to direct the RSPCB for taking action against the Proponent in accordance with the provisions of section 19 of the Environment (Protection), Act, 1986.
3. **Serial No.:7 to 9:** The SEAC-1 deferred these proposals in its 5A.61<sup>st</sup> and 5A.98<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 01<sup>st</sup>-03<sup>rd</sup> May 2023 and 28<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> November 2023, respectively. However, SEAC-1 mistakenly forwarded these proposals online on Parivesh 1.0 to SEIAA. Therefore, the Authority decided to **refer back these cases to SEAC-1** online on Parivesh portal 1.0 for examination and clarification in this regard.
4. **Serial No.:10:** The SEAC-2 deferred this proposal in its 5B.76<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> -22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2024. However, the SEAC-2 mistakenly forwarded the proposal online on Parivesh 1.0 to SEIAA. Therefore, the Authority decided to **refer back this case to SEAC-2** online on Parivesh portal 1.0 for examination and clarification in this regard.
5. **Serial No.:11:** The proposal was considered in the 5.115<sup>th</sup> meeting of 5<sup>th</sup> SEIAA held on 20.03.2024 and ADS was raised communicating the shortcomings observed by the Authority. The Project Proponent (PP) submitted the reply of the ADS in hard copy to this office on 22.07.2024, but failed to close the ADS online.





Even though the ADS was pending online and could not be locked in meeting agenda online, same was considered in the 5.135<sup>th</sup> meeting of 5<sup>th</sup> SEIAA held on 23.08.2024. During the meeting, the proposal was recommended for grant of EC and consequently, offline EC letter was issued on 29.08.2024.


However, the EC letter was not uploaded online. Also, the ADS was not closed by the PP until 05.03.2025.

The Authority is of the view that before taking decision pertaining to final disposal of this proposal, comments may be sought from the Member Secretary of previous SEIAA as to why the said proposal was considered offline in the Authority's meeting and subsequent EC was accorded even though the ADS was not closed online.

6. **Serial No.:12**: The proposal was considered in the 5.128<sup>th</sup> meeting of the SEIAA and was deferred in light of the shortcomings observed during the meeting and PP was directed to increase parking provisions in accordance with the NBC norms and to submit an affidavit that there will be no spillover of the vehicles outside the premises on the road. The reply submitted by the PP was examined and was found inadequate.

The Authority decided to **defer** this proposal for submission of additional documents viz., Valid NABET Certificate; signed copy of Disclosure of Consultant; sealed and signed layout plan, landscape plan and parking layout plan by Registered Architect; Affidavit by Architect regarding appointment of Architect for the project and that the maps submitted are as per building bylaws; Affidavit regarding applicability of General Conditions; a map indicating the distance of the project site from Critically Polluted Areas (CPAs) and Severely Polluted Areas (SPAs); Authenticated list of flora/fauna; Draft of Wildlife Conservation Plan for Schedule-I species along with the receipt of submission to concerned DCF and clarification regarding following:

- a) Number of Rainwater Harvesting Structures to be constructed in the submitted presentation (08 pits) and final conceptual plan (06 pits on Pg no. 43 and 04 pits on Pg no. 53) are not in coherence with each other. Needs clarification.






- b) The summation of fresh water requirement submitted under individual heads viz., shops, offices and restaurant staff (64.02 KLD) etc., is exceeding the total daily fresh water requirement of 40.56 KLD. PP is required to submit revised water balance.


7. **Serial No.: 13:** The proposal was considered in the 5.122<sup>th</sup> meeting of the SEIAA and was deferred in light of the shortcomings observed during the meeting.

The reply was examined by the Authority and was found inadequate and thus, the Authority decided to **defer** this proposal for submission of additional documents viz., Authenticated list of flora/fauna; Draft of Wildlife Conservation Plan for Schedule-I species along with the receipt of submission to concerned DCF; NOC from the concerned land holder for plantation outside the mining lease area and clarification regarding:

- a) The Khasra number mentioned in the Aravalli Certificate and Quarry License differs from those in the other submitted documents.
- b) Inconsistency in plantation details mentioned in the submitted presentation and Annexure-G. PP shall submit revised Annexure – G.
