

The proponent volunteered to provide water treatment plant to the **Chiyyedu** Village as a part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activity.

**Decision of SEIAA:-**Refer to SEAC to apprise with cluster letter. As per the cluster letter non-working period for some of the mines has not mentioned for calculating the cluster area.

The issue was placed in the 196<sup>th</sup> SEAC committee meeting held on 23/08/2022.

The Committee noted that as per cluster letter issued by Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Anantapuramu, vide Lr.4122/SEIAA-inf/2015 dated: 20.06.2022. There are **seven existing** quarry leases within the radius of 500 mts area and out of 7 leases 5 mine leases were not working for the past 5 years and one lease was not yet started quarry operations. Total cluster area is 4.44Ha.

The Committee after re-examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC' Notifications & OMs and detailed

deliberations, recommended to issue **Environmental Clearance** with a following conditions:

- 1. The proponent should controlled blasting because of highway is at 600 mts from quarry lease.
- 2. The proponent shall maintain plantation along the road side.
- 3. The proponent shall comply with the proposals furnished in Environmental management plan.

**Decision of SEIAA**:-Agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue Environmental Clearance.
