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### **Minutes of the 526<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) held on 01.12.2021**

Nodal Officer SEIAA brought to the notice of the SEIAA that the Department of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, UP vide letter no. 1229/81-7-2021-103(Parya/2007 TC dated 24.11.2021(copy enclosed) has desired as follows:- "...राज्य स्तरीय पर्यावरण प्रभाव प्राधिकरण में जनपद महोबा व अन्य जनपदों ने पत्थर खनन सम्बन्धी पर्यावरणीय अनापत्ति के लम्बित प्रकरणों के सम्बन्ध में दिनांक 25.11.2021 को विशेष बैठक आयोजित कर लम्बित प्रकरणों के निस्तारण के सम्बन्ध में नियमानुसार आवश्यक कार्यवाही सुनिश्चित कराते हुए कृत कार्यवाही से शासन को अविलम्ब अवगत कराने का कष्ट करें।"

In the light of the above letter dated 24.11.2021 agenda approved by MS, SEIAA is hereby put up for the consideration of SEIAA. Nodal officer, SEIAA placed files and documents related to below mentioned meetings of SEAC-1 & SEAC-2 before the SEIAA.

Nodal Officer, SEIAA-UP informed that in light of minutes of the meeting of joint meeting of SEIAA, SEAC-1 & SEAC-2 held on 22.06.2021, minutes of the below mentioned meetings of SEAC-2 have been vetted by SEAC-1.

#### **(A) Minutes of 599<sup>th</sup> SEAC-1 Meeting Dated- 26-11-2021**

##### **1. Sand Mining at Ghaghara River bed, Gata No.-02, Village- SharwaManjha, District- Faizabad, U.P., (Leased Area: 25.0 Ha) File NO. 4503/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/29241/2018**

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to close/ delist the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. A letter shall be send to DM, Faizabad to ensure that no mining activity is started until valid EC is obtained.



2. Stone(Khanda, Gitti& Boulder) & Red Morrum Mining at Gata No.-585, Khand No.-01,at Village- Bhandra, Tehsil-Mauranipur, District Jhansi, ShriChaudharyUbaid Ahmad ,Area-2.0 ha., File NO. 5904/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/176811/2020

SEIAA noted the comments of SEAC that the project proponent/consultant could not produce the final DSR; to be issued by the office of Directorate of Geology and Mining, UP and District administration, Jhansi. Therefore, the case is pending at the level of Directorate of Geology and Mining, UP and District administration, Jhansi for the issuance of final DSR. The project proponent/consultant is advised to pursue this case at the level of competent authority.

3. Stone Mining at Gata No./Araji No.-188mi, Village-Lahaura, Tehsil- Chunar, Mirzapur.,M/s Om Sai Construction, Area -0.809 ha File NO. 5012/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN /40217/2019

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project for along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC adding following specific condition as follows:-

1. This EC is co-terminus with validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier.
2. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
3. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
4. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
5. Three tier green shelter belt of 7.5m width should be developed on the periphery of mine lease area. Local and native species should be planted in consultation with Forest/Horticulture Department/Agriculture University.
6. Plan for using the mine void for productive use in consultation with local administration and gram-panchayat.
7. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
8. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 1,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Department of Geology & Mines, GoUP to carry out regional EIA-EMP report including carrying capacity of environmental components to assess the capacity to further bear the pollution load for such areas within a period of 1 year and submit the same to SEIAA, UP for evaluation.
11. Department of Geology & Mines, GoUP in consultation with UPSPCB will establish required number of CAAQMS in district within a period of one year and submit geo-referenced map of these stations along with data. Details of existing CAAQMS, if any, be submitted within a period of three months.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific condition regarding cluster certificate as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate" and adding following conditions:-

SEIAA took note of comment recorded by SEAC-1 in their meeting which is as follows-

"The committee observed that Environment Clearance for the said project was issued vide letter no.642/Parya/SEAC/4582/2018 dated 22/01/2013. SEAC-1 also noted that in the light of order passed by Hon' NGT dated 13/09/2018 in the matter of O.A. no. 186 of 2016 Satyendra Pandey Vs MoEF&CC and others SEIAA revoked the issued EC vide letter no. 642/Parya/SEAC/4582/2018 dated 23/01/2018 and the same was informed the Project Proponent Shri. Sandeep Mishra vide letter no.363/Parya/SEAC/4582/2018 dated 19/11/2019."

The Project Proponent has applied as a fresh application vide proposal no SIA/UP/MIN/58301/2020 on 21/10/2021 for issuance of the terms of References (ToR).The committee discussed the matter and recommended to issue the terms of References (ToR) for the preparation of EIA as annexed at annexure-1."

.....SEIAA opined that SEAC-1 should clearly elaborate upon issues on which Hon'ble NGT has cancelled the earlier EC and how the project proponent has proposed to address these issues in his proposal. For easy understanding this should be elaborated in a tabular form.

6. Stone Mining at Gata No.- 177, Village- Dhuria, Tehsil- Chunar, District- Mirzapur, Smt. Lalli, Area: 1.01 Ha. File No. 5998/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/58708/2020

SEIAA noted that in its 524th meeting the above project was granted EC. Hence no further action is required.

7. Soil Excavation at Gata No.-161, 164, 165, 166, 167 Village-Bhadri, Tehsil-Bilari, Moradabad, Shri Yogesh Chandra, area-0.549 ha. File No. 6558/Proposal No. SIA/UP /MIN/228714/2021

SEIAA agreed to grant EC to the above project but EC will be issued only when the project proponent submits notarized legible copy of agreement. SEIAA agreed to grant the prior Environmental Clearance with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific condition regarding cluster certificate as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster

provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate" and adding following conditions:-

1. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
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3. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
4. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 1,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.

8. Granite Mining at Gata No.- 1876, Khand No.-03, Village- Girawan, Naraini, Banda, Shri Suresh Pratap Singh, M/s Bajrang Road Lines, Leased Area - 1.41 ha. File No. 6560/6103/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/59596/2021

9. Sand Mining from Yamuna River bed at Khand No. 11, Village-Kanjasa, Tehsil-Bara, District-Allahabad, U.P. Area-8.0 Ha) File No. 3984

SEIAA noted the comments of SEAC to revoke the Environmental Clearance letter no. 172/Parya/SEAC/3894/2017, dated 12/02/2018 issued by SEIAA, U.P. in favour of Shri Udai Pratap Singh in light of District Magistrate, Prayagraj order dated 29/01/2021. Suitable order regarding revoking of EC to be issued.

SEIAA noted that 19 mine leases have been mentioned in DM Prayagraj order dated 29-01-2021. Hence SEIAA opined that a letter shall be sent to DM Prayagraj for status of remaining 18 mine leases.

10. Proposed Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad (Development of Multilevel Parking & Advocates Chamber) at Prayagraj, U.P., Shri Chotey Lal Kanaujia, R/o- Joint Registrar, Infrastructure, High Court, Allahabad. File No. 6523/6132/Proposal No. SIA /UP/MIS/ 66972/2021

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through the file and documents and found that the total plot area is mentioned in Sqr.mt. while water body inside the premises is mentioned in Sqr.Km. grazing land is also

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mentioned in the proposal. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall clarify the above.
