Indian Oil Corporation Limited, has applied for Environment Clearance for the proposed Augmentation of LPG Bottling capacity and LPG Bulk Storage capacity from 1000 MT to 1900 MT by installing 3x300 MT mounded storage unit at S.No: 376/2., of Kulathur Village, Srirangam Taluk, Thiruchirapalii District, Tamilnadu on 05.09.2015.</p> <p>The proposal was placed in the 92nd meeting of the SEAC held on 11.07.2017. Based on the presentation made by the proponent and the documents furnished, the SEAC decided to recommend the proposal for the grant of EC to SEIAA, subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the normal conditions:</p> |

From the presentation, it is learnt that a diploma school exists at about 800m from the plant site, Enamkulathur Village at about 3kms and Ganesh Nagar at 800m. As per the risk assessment study conducted by the proponent, there is a real threat to the diploma school and the Ganesh Nagar in the event of worst case scenario of explosion in the plant. The proponent should furnish details of specific risk management measures which will protect and safe guard these vulnerable habitations. 2. The proponent should submit the recent reports of the inspection conducted by authorities like Inspector of factories. 3. Regarding CSR activity, the proponent has not carried out adequate CSR activity so far and therefore they should spend Rs. |
