	The Project proponent informed the committee that the industry is having 124.33 Ha total mine area. Out of this 124.33 Ha, 57.04 Ha surrendered to Government vide letter dated 11.03.2022. After reduction of this area and maintaining of 200 meters buffer distance from habitation, this mine would not fall within 5 kms distance from the state boundary. The proponent has informed that, the land within 5km radius of the interstate boundary is not proposed for mining even earlier and they had applied for the surrender of the area and the approval is awaited.
	The Committee opined that the industry need to upload the Land reduction application showing the land beyond 5 kms distance from the interstate boundary along with proper plan and KML Map.
	Then, the project proponent requested the committee to withdraw the application and the same was informed infront of committee during the meeting to apply for


