Recommendations of the SEAC on 28.07.2022 Category: B1(Violation TOR)

The proposed project is for mining of **Garividi Manganese Ore** mine in an area of **21.587 Ha**. with a proposed production quantity of **Garividi Manganese Ore**— **50,000 TPA**with a condition that the total production during a scheme should be limited to the approved quantity as per Mining scheme/ plan.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (≤250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

Earlier, TOR was issued on 24.01.2019which is valid up to 3 years.subsequently the proponent has applied for TOR extension on 17.01.2022 stating that the project could not be taken up as the mining lease was valid p to 31.03.2020 only. Now the mine operator extended the lease upto19.08.24 vide GO 81 st 08.12.21. further informed that there is no change in production and the mine is not working since 2013 and requested to issue TOR for upto 23.01.2024 .As per S.O No.221 (E) dt. 18.01.2021, the period from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> march 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of TOR.

The proponent and their consultant BS EnvitechPvt Ltd have attended the meeting.

The project falls under B1 category as per the MoEF&CC Notification No. S.O.2269(E),dated 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2016. Life of mine is 42 years.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC' Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to issue Extension <u>TOR</u> withViolation and with Public Hearing up to 23.01.2024 with following additional TOR conditions.

- 1. The project proponent shall also implement existing TOR conditionsissued vide TOR order dt.24.01.2019.
- 2. The project proponent shall prepare cluster EIA and EMP.
- 3. The project proponent shall prepare detailed plantation plan.

- **4**. The project proponent shall prepare plan for surface runoff protection measures.
- 5. The project proponent shall submit forest NOC, implementation plan for conditions mentioned therein at the time of applying for EC.
- 6. The proponent is liable to pay the penalties as levied by the concerned competent authority, as per the OM No.28.1.2022 and clause No 12 of SOP dated07-07-2021, duly incorporating the total production during the violation period and submit the calculation of penalties based on the project cost and the total turnover during the violation period.
- 7. Credible action under section 15 read with section 19 of E (P) act, 1986 to be initiated by concerned Regional office, APPCB.
- 8. The project proponent shall carry assessment of ecological damage, remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan and it shall be prepared as an independent chapter in the environment impact assessment report by the accredited consultants. The collection and analysis of data for assessment of ecological damage, preparation of remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan shall be done by an environmental laboratory duly notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, or a environmental laboratory accredited by National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories, or a laboratory of a Council of Scientific and Industrial Research institution working in the field of environment.
- 9. The project proponent shall ensure implementation of Environmental Management Plan, comprising remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan corresponding to the ecological damage assessed and economic benefit derived due to violation.
- 10. The project proponent will be required to submit a bank guarantee equivalent to the amount of remediation plan and Natural and Community Resource Augmentation Plan with the State Pollution Control Board.
- 11. The project proponent shall give an undertaking by way of affidavit to comply with all the statutory requirements and judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2017 in writ petition (Civil) No.144 of 2014 in the matter of common cause verse union of India and Ors. Before grant of TOR/EC. The undertaking inter-alia includes commitment of the PP not to repeat any such violation in future.

The proposed project is for mining of **Road metal, building stone & Gravel** mine in an area of **3.237 Ha**with a proposed production quantity of **Gravel** –**1,00,000.81m3/annum, RM&BS** –**3,00,070.10m3/annum** ( **as per the Approved mining plan in page no.12)** with a condition that the total production during a scheme should be limited to the approved quantity as per Mining scheme/ plan.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (≤250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

The representative of proponent and their consultant Dr. P.Vijaya Kumar, RQPhave attended the meeting.

Earlier, the project proponent has obtained EC on 27.03.2022 with an extent of 3.237 Ha for the production capacity of Mining of Road metal and building stone- 83491.5 Cum/Annum & Gravel-20074.5 Cum/Annum. Now project proponent applied for EC expansion with production quantity of **Gravel** – 1,00,000.81 m3/annum, RM&BS –3,00,070.10m3/annum and the project proponent submittedDispatch particulars and status of quarryletter from ADMG, Anakapalli.

The Committee noted that as per cluster letter issued by the Assistant Director of Mines & Geology, Anakapalli has issued a letter vide dt. 31.05.2022 there 26 quarry lease existing within the radius of 500mts from the lease area. The total cluster area is 4.737 Ha which is <5.0 Ha.

The Committee noted that the extent of proposed mine lease area is **3.237 Ha.** The project falls under B2 category. Mine life 5 years.

The proponent volunteered to allocate funds at least 10% of the project cost for providing amenities to the local school / PHCs and development of village roads and to provide water treatment plant in the RongalivanipalemVillage as a part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activity.

**Decision of SEIAA in 187<sup>th</sup> meeting:-**Refer to SEAC to examine with the certified compliancereport.

Accordingly, the committee reexamined the proposal and noted that the project proponent had obtained Environmental clearance on 27/03/2022 and submitted Dispatch particulars and status of quarry letter from ADMG, Anakapalli vide letter

dt.31.05.2022. The mine lease has not started production as per the letter issued bythe ADMG letter dt.31.05.2022. The committee opined that the six monthly certified compliance does not arise as the mine has not started working and the six months. The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC' Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to issue Environmental Clearance for expansion with additional conditions. 1. The proponent shall comply with the proposals furnished in Environmental management plan. 2. The project proponent shall develop greenbelt along road side and shall take dust suppression measures. 3. The proponent shall provide 1.05KM trench (1mx1m) all along the boundary of lease area. 4. The project proponent shall develop compensatory afforestation. 5. The proponent shall minewith proper benches and to be maintained. **Decision of SEIAA:-**Agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue Environmental Clearance for expansion with additional conditions. Accordingly, the project proponent had obtained Environmental clearance on 07/04/2022 and the project has submitted the project proponent submitted Dispatch particulars and status of quarry letter from ADMG, Anakapalli vide letter dt.31.05.2022.

The mine lease was not yet executed as mentioned in the ADMG letter dt.31.05.2022.

**Decision of SEIAA:**-Refer to SEAC to examine the cluster situation as 3.237 Ha mine of Smt.B.Bhavani is adjacent to the proposed mine.

Smt. B.Bhavanimine is not listed in thecluster letter issued by the mines department and as such this mine does not fall under cluster condition. Hence the earlier decision holds good.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC' Notifications & OM's and detailed deliberations, recommended toissue Environmental Clearance with additional conditions.

- 1. The proponent shall comply with the proposals furnished in Environmental management plan.
- 2. The project proponent shall develop greenbelt in village roads and approach roads.
- 3. Proper benches should be maintained.
- 4. Compensation of Afforestation.

**Decision of SEIAA:-** Agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue Environmental Clearance.
