Mining of minerals (&lt;250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).</p> <p>Earlier, TOR was issued on 24.01.2019which is valid up to 3 years.subsequently the proponent has applied for TOR extension on 17.01.2022 stating that the project could not be taken up as the mining lease was valid p to 31.03.2020 only. Now the mine operator extended the lease upto19.08.24 vide GO 81 st 08.12.21. further informed that there is no change in production and the mine is not working since 2013 and requested to issue TOR for upto 23.01.2024 .As per S.O No.221 (E) dt. 18.01.2021, the period from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> march 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of TOR.</p> <p>The proponent and their consultant BS EnvitechPvt Ltd have attended the meeting.</p> <p>The project falls under B1 category as per the MoEF&amp;CC Notification No. S.O.2269(E),dated 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2016.
