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- The project shall include adequate rest rooms and sanitary facility for the drivers for overnight stay
- 2. The project proponent has to provide rain water collection tank of 1200 cu.m capacity in order to recover and reuse the rain water during normal rains in addition to other structure proposed for rain water harvesting. Furnish the location of the tank and allied piping.
- The project activity shall not result to any adverse impact to biodiversity , water bodies and agriculture activities in the vicinity of the project site
- 4. The project shall establish signal facility at the entry and exit at their cost in consultation with the traffic police for smooth flow of vehicles
- During the operation phase the project shall support eco tourism/nature tourism promoted by tourism and forest department
- The MSW facility shall be put up under closed building to abate bird menace as the project site is locate close to the airport.
