CONSIDERATION/RECONSIDERATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE

1. SIA/KL/MIS/117155 /2019, File No. 1438/EC3/2019/SEIAA

Decision: The Committee decided to accept the Field Inspection Report and the proponent is directed to submit the following documents/Details:

- Revised CER programme suitable for the local environment and people. Revised remediation plan and natural resource augmentation plan to compensate damage done to the environment and incorporating fruitful measures to augment natural resources in the area. Economic gain as per a Chartered Accountant's report must also be considered while preparing remediation plan. A detailed green belt development plan prepared in consultation with a professional agency/expert.
- Detailed proposal to harness solar energy in the project area and measures proposed for energy conservation.
- A revised site plan having an emergency entrance/exit route.
- Latest water quality report of proposed water sources and treated drinking water.
- Yield test report of proposed water sources.

2. SIA/KL/MIS/ 119987/2019, File No. 1468/EC3/2019/SEIAA

Decision: The Committee decided to accept the Field Inspection Report and the proponent is directed to submit the following documents/Details:

- Entrance road from the main road should be widened to 12-meter width with separate lines for incoming and outgoing traffic.

- The site plan should be modified by including a separate emergency exit to main road.
- The STP and intermediate storage of bio medical waste are planned near the entrance. It should be ensured that there is no inconvenience to the general public due to this. The intermediate storage of bio medical waste should be relocated.
- A yield test of the water sources should be done to ensure the adequacy of these sources.
- The open well in the entrance should be suitably protected to avoid contamination.
- The project is designed in two phases. So CER should be phase- wise with detailed break up.
- Details of utilization of earth removed from the project area.
- Details of parking facility proposed during operational phase should be reworked.
- Considering the location surrounded by roads and houses, a detailed site-specific plan for planting/greening up should be prepared with the help of an expert and should be a part of the plan.
- Storm water management should be site - specific ensuring that excess water is channeled to a canal. The drainage channel opposite to the project site should be suitably developed to ensure free flow.
- Details of harnessing solar energy.
