## MINUTES OF THE 59<sup>th</sup> GOA STATE ENVIRONMENT IMPACT ASSESSMENT AUTHORITY (GOA-SEIAA) MEETING HELD ON 18/06/2021 AT 04.00 PM. IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE 4<sup>th</sup> FLOOR, DEMPO TOWER, PATTO, PANAJI-GOA.

The fifty nineth meeting of the Goa-SEIAA (*hereinafter referred as* 'Authority') was held on  $18^{th}$  February 2021 at 04.00 pm. in the conference room,4<sup>th</sup> floor, Dempo Tower, Patto, Panaji. The list of members present during the meeting is annexed (*refer Annexure – 1*).

At the outset, Chairman welcomed Authority member and briefed about the agenda items (*refer Annexure* -2) to be taken up for discussion / deliberations and suitable decisions. Accordingly, the same were considered as detailed below -

As directed by the GSEIAA in its 58<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 11/05/2021 through video conference. The project proponent had submitted the revised plan showing the additional gate for entry/ exit towards the property bearing survey no. 326/- of village Dhargal and also EIA report of the proposed project.

After going through the proposed plan and EIA report of project proponent, the Authority decided to inspect the site in question before grant of approval.

Accordingly, the inspection was carried out by the Authority members on 08/06/2021 at 4.00pm in presence of project proponent namely Mr. Harish Shinde,GCA, Shri. Vijay Kumar Samant, Architect and Mr. Amar Bakar.

During the inspection it was noticed as below:-

- 1. The Additional gate which is shown is opening in the private property for which there does not exist any road.
- There is no proper developed road exist at site and the project proponent is using the service road of WRD – Tillari Irrigation Cannal.
- 3. There requires extensive hill cutting which will substantially damage the environment.
- 4. There exists a very rich ecosystem of specialized flora and fauna unique to the Goan Laterite Pleateus.

The SEAC may re-examined the proposal with observations raised in above points and other relevant point which deemed fit. Meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair.
