### C. <u>APPRAISAL OF DISTRICT SURVEY REPORTS (SAND, MORRUM AND ROAD METAL)</u> OF DISTRICT BALASORE:

The SEAC had earlier appraised the District Survey Reports (Sand, Morrum and Road metal) of Balasore district and given its recommendations in its meeting held on 20.08.2022. However, the SEAC observed that basic information such as preparation of DSR by MoEF&CC, Govt. of India Accredited Agency/Consultant, mining reserve of sand shall be finalized based on sand replenishment study etc. as recommended in the proceedings have not been included in the DSRs, as forwarded by SEIAA for consideration.

After detailed discussion, the SEAC recommended that SEIAA may consider for approval of the DSRs after compliance of points raised by SEAC in its meeting held on 20.08.2022.
