Actions on the recommendations of 11th meeting of the SEAC held on 5th December, 2020.

1. **EC for collection of Silt from “Kamalabari/Garukhuti/Bhakat Chapori-Plot-7” under Majuli (T) Forest Dvn. M/S T.K. Engineering Consortium Pvt. Ltd. (SEIAA.1111/2020, (Proposal no. SIA/AS/MIN/45182/2019)**

SEAC Resolution 11/3:

The project proposal submitted by M/s T.K. Engineering Consortium Pvt Ltd requesting EC to extract silt from Kamalabari/ Garukhuti/ Bhakat Chapori-Plot-7 is deliberated in the SEAC meeting. Due deliberation is made in the meeting and the committee approved the project proposal for issue of EC against mining of 123625 Cu.M of silt from the proposed location in two years period (*as mentioned in the page No. 10 of the approved Mining Plan*). Annual extractable quantity of silt is approved 61812.5 Cu.M. The project proponent has to strictly follow all the terms & condition laid down in the approved Mining Plan.

The DFO, Majuli(T) Forest Division is requested to ensure regular monitoring of the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period.

After due deliberation the committee approved the project proposal for issuance of EC for extraction of silt on the basis of the approved mining plan. Accordingly, minable volume of silt is approved 1,15,282 Cu.M for 2 (two) year period. Annual extractable quantity of silt is approved 57,641 Cu.M. The project proponent shall have to strictly adhere to the terms & condition laid down in the approved Mining Plan.

3. EC for collection of Silt from “Sumoimari/ Plot-5” under Majuli (T) Forest Divnby M/s. T.K. Engineering Consortium Pvt. Ltd. (SEIAA.1109/2020) (Proposal No. SIA/AS/MIN/45282/2019)

SEAC Resolution 11/5:

The project proposal submitted by M/s T.K. Engineering Consortium Pvt. Ltd requesting EC for extraction of silt from **Sumoimari/Plot-5** under Majuli (T) Forest Division is deliberated in the meeting. Going through the records and after due discussion the committee approved the project for extraction of minable volume of 102824 Cu.M of silt from the proposed location in 2 (two) years period. Considering the approved mining plan 51412 Cu.M of silt is approved to extract annually.

The P.P has to strictly follow the terms & condition contained in the approved Mining Plan during the mining operation.

6. EC for extraction of Sand/ Gravel from “Nunoi No.1 Sand/ Stone Mahal” under Dhansiri Forest Division by Fwilo Basumatary. SEIAA.1440/2020 (SIA/AS/MIS/177314/2020)

SEAC Resolution 11/10:

The Project Proposal submitted by Sri Fwilo Basumatary requesting for extension the validity of the earlier EC issued dated 5th Aug/2015 for mining of sand and stone for another 2 (two) years as per approved mining plan.

Annual extractable quantity of sand gravel 3513 Cu.M and 31623 Cu.M of boulder is approved.

9. **EC for extraction of River Silt from “Gumi Tapar Pathar Brahmaputra River Silt MPA” under Kamrup West Dvn by Shree Gautam Construction Co. Ltd. SEIAA.1420/2020 (Proposal No. SIA/AS/MIS/185591/2020)**

SEAC Resolution 11/13:

The project proposal submitted by Shree Gautam Construction Co. Ltd asking EC against mining of river silt from “Gumi Tapar Pathar Brahmaputra River Silt MPA” under Kamrup West Dvn is placed before the SEAC for discussion.

On examining the documents and after due discussion the committee approved the proposal to issue EC against extraction of river silt from 3.0774 Ha area at Gumi Tapar Pathar Brahmaputra river silt MPA under Kamrup West Division. 30,000Cu.M of river silt is approved to be extracted in 2 (two) years period following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved Mining Plan during the mining operation. The annual extractable quantity of silt is approved 15,000Cu.M.


SEAC Resolution 11/20:

On examining the documents furnished by the P.P including the additional documents submitted by the PP, the committee approved the project for extraction of 1500 Cu.M of sand and 500 Cu.M of silt from the proposed location in two year period. Annual extractable quantity 750 Cu.M sand and 250 Cu.M silt is approved. Further, the P.P has to ensure that the proposed site shall have to be converted into a fishery tank after executing the proposed mining on 0.95 Ha area as advised by the Mine Planner. The P.P shall have to obey all the terms and condition laid down in the approved Mining Plan.



15. Proposal for New Umrangshu limestone” Dima Hasao (TOR) by M/s NECEM Cements. SEIAA. 1145/2020

SEAC Resolution 11/22:

The project proposal submitted by M/S NECEM Cements Ltd for mining of Limestone at New Umarangshu under Dima Hasao District is placed before the committee for discussion. In between, a subcommittee constituted with the Hon’ble Members of SEAC visited the proposed site and submitted their field inspection report on 5/12/2020 which has also been discussed in the meeting. After thorough discussion the committee resolved to approve the project for issuance of TOR. Standard TOR may be issued incorporating the additional points given below.

1. Mine waste disposal and municipal waste disposal plans.
2. Mine pit water/ treatment and removable/ discharge plan if such case arise.
3. Details of Vehicular movement during operation of the mine at day time as well as night – time.
4. Details mine closure plan including plantation in the mining lease area.
5. Details geology, geomorphology, land use maps to a radius of 10 km from the lease area should the proposed on 1:25000 Seale.
6. CSR Scheme details should be given.
7. Details of explosives to be used and storage facility of explosives.
8. The Geology and geological structures of the mine area should be detailed in the report correctly as the pre-feasibility report submitted by the applicants contains some elements of Rajasthan.

16. Proposal for New Umrangshu limestone” Dima Hasao (TOR) by M/S AMDCL(SEIAA. .1146/2020

SEAC Resolution 11/23:


The project proposal submitted by M/S AMDCL for mining of Limestone in New Umarangshu area under Dima Hasao District is placed before the committee by discussion. In the meantime, the subcommittee constituted with Hon’ble Member of SEAC visited the proposed site and submitted their field inspection report on 5/12/2020. The committee after due discussion resolved to issue TOR for the proposed proposal. It is further resolved that the standard TOR may be issued incorporating the following additional points as evolved during the field inspection. The additional points are


1. Mine waste disposal and municipal waste disposal plans.
2. Mine pit water/ treatment and removable/ discharge plan if such case arise.
3. Details of Vehicular movement during operation of the mine at day time as well as night – time.
4. Details mine closure plan including plantation in the mining lease area.
5. Details geology, geomorphology, land use maps to a radius of 10 km from the lease area should the proposed on 1:25000 Seale.
6. CSR Scheme details should be given.
7. Details of explosives to be used and storage facility of explosives.
8. The Geology and geological structures of the mine area should be detailed in the report correctly as the pre-feasibility report submitted by the applicants contains some elements of Rajasthan.




