The PP has not submitted mining plan duly approved by Indian Bureau of Mines.

Serial No. 4.- The SEAC 1 upon appraisal of the project in the light of information contained in Form-1, Form-2, Prefeasibility report and other documents and having regard to the submissions made during presentation, resolved to recommend to SEIAA for grant of EC to with the stipulation that the PP shall abide by the annual production schedule specified in mining plan and that any deviation there in will render the PP liable for legal action in accordance with Environment and Mining Laws, with the specific and general conditions.

The Authority decided to defer this proposal for submission of additional documents viz. valid NABET certificate, Certified Production figures upto FY 2024-25, Approved copy of DSR, Certified Compliance Report for the latest EC, validity extension of LoI letter issued for inclusion of mineral, approved Conservation Plan, and NOC regarding plantation in the outside area, within next 45 days.

Certified Production figures upto FY 2024-25, Approved copy of DSR, Compliance of earlier CCR reg. advertisement of EC copy in newspaper, Certified Compliance Report for the latest EC, Valid NABET certificate and NOC regarding plantation in the outside area, within next 45 days.

8. **Serial No. 21.**— The SEAC 1 upon appraisal of the project in the light of information contained in Form-1, Form-2, Prefeasibility report and other documents and having regard to the submissions made during presentation, resolved to recommend to SEIAA for grant of EC to with the stipulation that the PP shall abide by the annual production schedule specified in mining plan and that any deviation there in will render the PP liable for legal action in accordance with Environment and Mining Laws, with the specific and general conditions.

The Authority decided to defer this proposal for submission of additional documents viz. valid NABET certificate, Certified Production figures upto FY 2024-25, Approved copy of DSR, Certified Compliance Report for the latest EC and approved Conservation Plan within next 45 days.

9. **Serial No. 22.**— The SEAC 1 upon appraisal of the project in the light of information contained in Form-1, Form-2, Prefeasibility report and other documents and having regard to the submissions made during presentation, resolved to recommend to SEIAA for grant of EC to with the stipulation that the PP shall abide by the annual production schedule specified in mining plan and that any deviation there in will render the PP liable for legal action in accordance with Environment and Mining Laws, with the specific and general conditions.

The Authority decided to defer this proposal for submission of additional documents viz. valid NABET certificate, Certified Production figures upto FY 2024-25, Approved copy of DSR, Compliance of earlier CCR point No. 10 of General conditions, Certified Compliance Report for the latest EC and approved Conservation Plan within next 45 days.

10. **Serial No. 26, 27.** The Authority accepted the recommendations along with the additional conditions submitted by SEAC and decided to grant EC to these proposals.
11. **Serial No. 28.** The Committee, upon appraisal of the project and having regard to the information contained in Form-1, PFR and presentation made by the PP/Consultant, considering the inputs of the honorable committee resolved to recommend to SEIAA for Grant of ToR to Proposed Industrial area Amberi with

the stipulation that the PP shall abide with the specific and general conditions. Besides the general conditions, the Committee also resolved to recommend to SEIAA to impose additional conditions.

The Authority decided to defer this proposal for submission of additional documents viz. Affidavit regarding No violation of EIA Notification 2006, Affidavit for applicability of General Conditions., within next 45 days.

Besides the general conditions, the Committee also recommend to SEIAA to impose additional conditions.

The Authority decided to defer this proposal for submission of additional documents viz. Affidavit regarding No violation of EIA Notification 2006, Affidavit for applicability of General Conditions., Signed copy of Form-1, and certificate from concerned DCF regarding distance of project from National Park/Wildlife sanctuary within next 45 days.

13. **Serial No. 30.** The SEAC, after consideration of the information contained in the Form-1, Form-1 A, conceptual plan, and PFR and other documents and having regard to the submissions made during presentation, recommended to SEIAA for grant of EC for Expansion In The Industrial Shed for Nitin Spinners Limited, Unit Begun" to Nitin Spinners Limited with standard and specific conditions.

The Authority decided to defer this proposal for submission of additional documents viz. Affidavit regarding No violation of EIA Notification 2006, Affidavit for applicability of General Conditions, and certificate from concerned DCF regarding distance of project from National Park/Wildlife sanctuary within next 45 days.

14. **Serial No. 31.** The PP/consultant was not present during the meeting. The Authority decided to defer this proposal.
15. **Serial No. 32.** The Committee, upon appraisal of the project and having regard to the information contained in Form-1, PFR and presentation made by the PP/Consultant, considering the inputs of the honorable committee recommended to SEIAA for Grant of ToR to Proposed Textile Park Rupaheli, under the jurisdiction of RIICO Unit Bhilwara Rajasthan, with the stipulation that the PP shall abide with the specific, general conditions and additional conditions.

The Authority decided to defer this proposal for submission of additional documents viz. Affidavit regarding No violation of EIA Notification 2006, Affidavit for applicability of General Conditions, and certificate from concerned DCF regarding distance of project from National Park/Wildlife sanctuary within next 45 days.

16. Serial No. 33, The SEAC-1 considered/examined the project proposal in its meeting 5A.117th held on 27th and 28th February 2024. PP has submitted the proposal under the violation category. The Committee observed that the proposal falls under violation category. The Committee took note of OM issued by MoEF & CC no. F.No.IA3-3/4/2024-IA.III (E 230791) dated 8th Jan 2024 vide which it was communicated that the OM dated 7th July 2021 & 28th Jan 2022 has been stayed by Hon'ble Supreme court vide order dated 02.01.2024 in WP(C) no. 1394/2023. In view of above, the committee recommended that proposal cannot be appraised till the outcome of above WP (C) no. 1394/2023 and/or any further OM issued by the MOEF & CC and to return the proposal to SEIAA for taking a view on above legal issue.


The Authority in its meeting 5.118th Meeting held on 16 th April, 2024 has defer this proposal in light of the O.M. No. IA3-3/4/2024-IA.III [E 230791] dated 08.01.2024 issued by MoEF & CC regarding stay imposed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P.(C) No. 1394/2023 titled Vanshakti vs. Union of India, with reference to the SOP dated 7th July 2021 and OM dated 28th January 2022. Now, the PP vide mail dated 15.04.2025, requested to process their proposal for further proceeding. The MoEF&CC, in compliance of orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 06.01.2025 issued a notification dated 28th March, 2025 that all projects that have applied under the provision of OM dated 07/07/2021 and which are pending as on 02/01/2024 may be processed.


The Authority decided to refer back this proposal to SEAC-2 for examination the proposal in light of the aforementioned Office memorandum.
