

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF STATE LEVEL EXPERT APPRAISAL  
COMMITTEE, ODISHA HELD ON 31<sup>ST</sup> MAY, 2019**

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The SEAC met on 31<sup>ST</sup> May, 2019 at 03:00 PM in the Conference Hall of Odisha State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar under the Chairmanship of Sri. B.P Singh. The following members were present in the meeting.

The agenda-wise proceedings and recommendations of the committee are detailed below:

**A. CONSIDERATION OF MINOR MINERAL PROPOSALS:**

1. The SEAC in its meeting held on 15.04.2019 had recommended the following:
  - a) The SEIAA, Odisha may consider to seek advice of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India about processing and appraisal of minor mineral proposals in view of order of the Hon'ble NGT, New Delhi dated 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 and whether amendment of EIA Notification will be required for the purpose.
  - b) The proposals of minor minerals pending with the SEAC will be returned to SEIAA, Odisha till these proposals are submitted with District Survey Report and a clarification received from MoEF&CC, Govt. of India as per the orders of Hon'ble NGT.
2. The SEAC has received 1 no. of minor mineral proposal from SEIAA, Odisha for appraisal. Further, as verified from the online system (in first phase), there are 29 minor mineral proposals are pending at the proponent end due to want of information.

After detailed discussion, the SEAC decided to return these 30 nos. of minor mineral proposals (**as per Annexure - I**) to SEIAA, Odisha for further action as per the above decision of the SEAC. The SEAC also recommended to delist 29 nos. of proposals (other than Sl. No. 1 of **Annexure - I**) as per MoEF&CC, Govt. of India OM No.J-11013/5/2009-IA-II (Part) dated 30th October, 2012.

**B. CONSIDERATION OF COUNTRY LIQUOR PROPOSALS**

The committee verified the application furnished in Form-I along with documents and checklist of 05 nos. of country liquor proposals. The recommendations of the committee are as follows:

- a) The SEAC considered the proposal (enclosed as **Annexure - II**) as 'B2' category as the unit is generating waste water less than 100 KLD and recommended to take decision on the proposal after the proponent submits the details of process of ETP (page-38 of pre-feasibility report) along with detailed flow sheet of ETP.

b) Resubmission of 04 nos. of proposals for appraisal at SEAC, Odisha as per MoEF&CC, Govt. of India communication / EDS:

The SEAC observed the following:

- (i) The MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide S.O. 1599(E), dated 25.06.2014 issued amended EIA Notification, 2006. General condition of this amended EIA Notification stipulates "**Any project or activity specified in Category 'B' will be appraised at the central level as Category A, if located in whole or in part within 05 km from the boundary of: (i) Protected Areas notified under the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, (ii) Critically Polluted areas as notified by the Central Pollution Control Board from time to time, (iii) Notified Eco-sensitive areas, (iv) Inter-State boundaries and international boundaries**".
- (ii) The SEAC, Odisha while appraisal of 04 nos. of country liquor proposals as per **Annexure – III**, found that these units are located within 05 kms from boundary of Critically Polluted Area of Angul – Talcher and/or inside the Critically Polluted Areas of Angul- Talcher and hence, general condition is applicable as above. Accordingly, the SEAC returned the proposal to SEIAA, Odisha with a request to ask the proponent to apply for EC to MoEF&CC, Govt. of India as category - A project as the unit is located within 05 kms from boundary of Critically Polluted Area of Angul – Talcher and/or inside the Critically Polluted Area of Angul -Talcher.
- (iii) The SEIAA, Odisha returned these proposals to the proponents to apply to MoEF&CC, Govt. of India as category – A projects.
- (iv) The proponents of these projects have resubmitted the proposals to SEIAA, Odisha for grant of Environmental Clearance with an intimation that they had applied to MoEF&CC, Govt. of India for grant of Environmental Clearance as category – A project and they have received EDS by the Member Secretary, Industry – II stating that "**The proposals require appraisal at the State Level by the SEAC / SEIAA as Moratorium for consideration of development projects have been lifted from Angul-Talcher area**".
- (v) The MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide OM No. J-011013/05/2010-IA.II(I), dated 13.01.2010 had imposed temporary restriction on grant of Environmental Clearance of developmental projects in Critically Polluted Areas including Critically Polluted Area of Angul – Talcher area and accordingly, a Moratorium period was fixed for submission of action plan for Critically Polluted Area by the State Pollution Control Board for lifting of Moratorium period.
- (vi) The Moratorium period was lifted for Critically Polluted Area of Angul - Talcher area vide OM No. J-011013/05/2010-IA.II(I), dated 31.03.2011.
- (vii) The Moratorium period was fixed for Critically Polluted Areas for grant of Environmental Clearance and it is not linked with applicability of general conditions for projects. General condition applicability for the project as per Schedule of EIA Notification is there from date of EIA Notification, 2006 i.e. 14<sup>th</sup> September 2006. There is no Circular or Office Memorandum issued by the

MoEF&CC, Govt. of India about non-applicability of general conditions for the Critically Polluted Areas where Moratorium period has been lifted.

After detailed discussion, the SEAC decided to return these 04 applications to SEIAA, Odisha with a request to request MoEF&CC, Govt. of India to advise with Circular or Office Memorandum of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India if any that general condition is not applicable for the projects located within the Critically Polluted Area or within 05 km from boundary of Critically Polluted Area where Moratorium period for such Critically Polluted Area has been lifted.




