



The committee noted that CRZ clearance was issued on 13.12.2021



The representative of proponent i.e., joint director , fisheries dept and their consultant WAPCOS Limited have attended the meeting on 03.06.22 and informed that they have replied ADS and further submitted that they could not carry latest analysis owing to prevailing corona conditions. It is also informed that there will not be significant change in analysis as there was no environmental intervention change in ground level during this period and assured to conduct the same at the earliest with a request to consider the application. The District Collector & District Magistrate, Srikakulam District has addressed a letter dt.02.09.21 to CCLA to accord permission for advance possession of land as the it is govt land. It is under process at CCLA . The site is recommended by CICEF. Fresh water consumption is 141 KLD and waste water generation is 50KLD. Project cost is 332.09 crores.
