Agenda 2:


(ii) The District Survey Report (DSR) on the sand mining proposal submitted by Deptt. Geology & Mines for the districts of Papumpare and Tawang was examined in detail and found to be not satisfactory.

The Authority decided to return the proposal for resubmission to the Expert Committee (SEAC), with following study details to be made available:

- (a) The consent from the local community and its people obtained through appropriate social consultation.
- (b) Study of Environmental impacts at various sand mining sites and management / site specific mitigation measures.
