Global Environment & Mining Services has attended the meeting.</p> <p>The committee noted that this an existing mine involving violation of EIA Notification, 2006.</p> <p>This is an existing mine, earlier the PP applied for TOR under violation category to the SEIAA on 19.02.2020.</p> <p>The project proponent vide letter dated 23.11.2021 stated that, this mining project M/s. Madhava Projects (4.65 Ha) has obtained orders from a) Project Management Office, Chief Construction Engineer (R&D)S, DRDO, Ministry of Defence, Visakhapatnam and b) Project Varsha of Indian Navy at Ramballi, Visakhapatnam for supply of Aggregates and Rock Boulders. In view of the time bound national importance of the project, the proponent requested to issue TOR without Public Hearing.</p> <p>The project falls under B2 category as per the MoEFCC Notification No. S.O.2269(E), dated 1st July, 2016.</p> <p>The committee noted the MoEF&CC, GoI, New Delhi issued the Standard operating Procedure (SoP) for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification 2006 vide Office Memorandum dated 7th July, 2021. Subsequently, the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Tamil Nadu on 15th July, 2021 issued Order "The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change have issued the impugned office memorandum. Thus, from what we have noted above, we are of the clear view that the petitioner has made out a prima facie case for entertaining the writ petition.
