The validity of the TOR will be for three years as per OM issued by MoEF and CC on 29.08.2017.

PP to submit Form - 2 along with EIA/EMP report as per OM issued by MoEF&CC on 20.04.2018.

PP informed that, they applied for prior Environmental Clearance on 13.04.2020, the proposal was considered by the SEAC-1 and recommended to the SEIAA for the grant of for prior Environmental Clearance in their 183rd meeting held on 14.05.2020 with following condition as one of the condition,

Condition No.5: PP to obtain permission for discharge of effluent to the CETP from Competent Authority. In case such permission is not granted, PP to provide ZLD Effluent Treatment Plant.

Thereafter, the proposal was considered by the SEIAA in their 206th meeting held on 10.09.2020 wherein it was decided to grant prior Environmental Clearance to the PP.

Accordingly the for prior Environmental Clearance was granted to the PP vide letter dated 28.10.2020 with following General Condition No.1

“PP to achieve Zero Liquid Discharge; PP shall ensure that, there is no increase in the Effluent load to CETP.”

PP informed that, at the time of SEIAA meeting permission from CETP was not obtained.

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PP also informed that, now they have obtained the permission from Lote - Parshuram Environmental Protection Co-operative Society Ltd. vide letter dated 17.07.2021. Hence, requested to remove the General Condition No.1 from their prior Environmental Clearance letter dated 28.10.2020.

After going through various documents presented by the PP; SEAC-1 observed that,

1. SEAC-1 recommended the proposal allowing PP to discharge their effluent to CETP subject to obtaining permission from the Competent Authority.
2. At the time of proposal being considered by the SEIAA; PP was not having permission from the CETP Co-operative Society.
3. PP obtained permission from the Lote - Parshuram Environmental Protection Co-operative Society Ltd. vide letter dated 17.07.2021.
4. It was evident from the web site of the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board that, the CETP of Lote-Parshuram is partially complying with the stipulated norms.

1	DMO to demarcate the proposed sand ghat with geo-referencing clearly providing adequate space for necessary infrastructure and facilities as presented in the layout
2	The District Collector shall ensure that, the final lease be granted only after ensuring the river bed is dry. No sand mining activity be carried out if there is water in the river bed
3	The District Collector shall ensure that, the approach road from the proposed sand ghat to the sand storage depot is properly identified and demarcated with the consent of the concern land owners /local authority before issuing final lease document
4	PP to monitor the groundwater level during sand quarrying operations, a network of existing wells may be established around the sand quarrying area and piezometers shall be installed at all sand quarry sites. Monitoring of Groundwater Quality in the vicinity (one kilometre radius from the sand quarrying site) shall be carried out once in two months
5	PP to ensure that, suitable depots shall be located in the vicinity of the sand quarry site to facilitate the sale of sand. While selecting the site for depots, it must be ensured that the site is within 25 km from the sand quarry site and has an area of around 10-15 Acres with parking facility and proper entry and exit for smooth movement of the vehicles. The depot site shall preferably be a Government land, foreshore area of tank bund etc. near an NH/SH/MDR/ODR.
