To consider the proposal for the grant of Environmental Clearance for the Proposed project for expansion of existing steel melting plant and rolling mill from 27,000 TPA to 90,000 TPA of MS Billets and 60,000 TPA to 90,000 TPA of Re-rolled steel in the existing steel plant of M/s. GBR Metals Pvt Ltd located at S.F.No. 111/2B,2C1,2C2,2D2A,2D3A,2E1A,2E2A,1A,1B & 2A2 Peravallur Village, Ponneri Taluk, Tiruvallur District under category B1 and item No. 3 (a), Metallurgical Industries ( Ferrous & Non-Ferrous ) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006.	5300	Discussed in detail, the Authority decided to recommend the project for the issue of Environmental Clearance subject to the following conditions. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Land distribution table did not include land required for raw material storage. Hence, the industry has to acquire additional land/ set aside required to satisfy this component before seeking CTO.</li> <li>2. Since the present AAQ levels exceeds the AAQ standard prescribed by the CPCB/TNPCB. The Project Proponent has to carry out comprehensive EIA study to identify and address the mitigation measures so as to ensure AAQ in the closed periphery of the plant to meet the AAQ standards prescribed by CPCB/TNPCB and submit to SEIAA and TNPCB before obtaining CTO.</li> <li>3. The adequate water storage</li> </ol>

  
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			facilities shall be established to meet the water demand for fire accident as well as wetting the coal yard continuously to prevent any fire.
2.	To consider the proposal for the grant of Environmental Clearance for the proposed expansion of basic organic chemicals manufacturing facility from 1892.2 TPA to 2119.2 TPA by M/s. Pharmazell (India) Pvt Ltd (Unit-I) at S.No: 164/1, Plot No. B5 & B6, MEPZ, Kadaperi Village, Tambaram Taluk, Kancheepuram District, Tamilnadu – Category “B1”-5(f) Synthetic Organic Chemical Industry (Dyes and Dye Intermediate).	6100	Discussed in detail, the Authority decided to recommend the project for the issue of Environmental Clearance subject to the following conditions. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The salt recovered from the Effluent treatment system shall not be disposed into the secured landfill, in order to prevent ground water pollution problems, being a highly soluble substance.</li> <li>2. The project proponent shall earmark adequate funds to develop R&amp;D for the recovery and reuse of salt within the reasonable time frame in consultation with TNPCB.</li> <li>3. The project proponent shall explore alternate technologies to reduce or prevent use of salt in the manufacturing process.</li> <li>4. The Project Proponent has to provide rain water harvesting collection tank to the capacity of 220 cu.m in order to recover and reuse the rain water during normal rains.</li> </ol>
