

**Minutes of the 93<sup>rd</sup> SEAC Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2017**

<p><b>93-06</b> <b>F.6429</b></p>	<p><b>Proposed Modification of existing Commercial complex into Hospital by M/s. MGM Health Care Pvt. Ltd., at T.S.No: 3/1 , Block No. 5 of Vada Agaram Village, Egmore - Nungambakkam Taluk, Chennai District, Tamilnadu – Category “B2”-8(a) Building &amp; Construction Projects - Environmental Clearance- Regarding</b></p>
	<p>The Proponent, <b>M/s. MGM Health Care Pvt. Ltd.</b>, has applied for Environment Clearance for the proposed <b>Modification of existing Commercial complex into Hospital</b> with built up area of <b>32101.01 Sq.m.</b> at T.S.No: 3/1 , Block No. 5 of Vada Agaram Village, Egmore - Nungambakkam Taluk, Chennai District, Tamilnadu on 02.08.2017.</p> <p>The proposal was placed in the 93<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the SEAC held on 12.08.2017. Based on the presentation made by the proponent and the documents furnished, the <b>SEAC decided to recommend the proposal for the grant of EC to SEIAA, subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the normal conditions:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The project involves demolition of part of the existing commercial building. The demolition activity should be carried out as per approved procedure stipulated by the Corporation of Chennai and the demolition waste should be managed again as per the rules prescribed.</li> <li>2. The Green Belt Development proposed should be strengthened by going for additional tree planting in areas in between the two blocks. The proponent also informed that they are going for vertical gardening also. The proponent</li> </ol>

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	<p>should furnish revised green belt development plan on these lines.</p> <p>3. For CSR activity an amount of Rs. 25 Lakhs should be spent for infrastructure facilities in Chennai Girls Higher Secondary school, Aminjikarai before obtaining completion certificate.</p> <p>4. The proponent has also agreed to offer the benefit of concessional treatment (50% cost) for atleast 50 patients per year for economically weaker section for major ailments. The proponent must provide an affidavit in this regard.</p>
