The Proponent, M/s. Anjan Drug Private Limited., has applied for Environment Clearance for the proposed enhancement of production capacity without any additional or new infrastructure of the existing bulk drug unit at SIDCO Industrial Estate at S.No: 237/1 (p), 235 (p), 236 (p), Plot No. 109, 110, 115 & 116, Alathur Village, Thiruporur Taluk, Kancheepuram District, Tamil Nadu on 21.07.2017.

Terms of Reference (ToR) was issued vide Lr.No SEIAA-TN/F.No. 6427/SEAC-XCIII/5(f)/ToR-283/2017 dated: 21.08.2017. The proponent submitted the EIA report on 21.11.2017.

The proposal (EIA report) was placed in the 98th meeting of the SEAC held on 28.11.2017.

1. ADPL has developed a green belt area of 0.12 acre in the existing facility. As the total area of the land is 2 acres, 0.66 acre should be under green belt as per the norms. When this was pointed out to the proponent during the meeting, the proponent proposed that there is shortage of area within the premises and hence additional green belt can be created only outside the premises if

the SEAC desires so. However, the members of the SEAC felt that it will be better to ascertain the land availability for the green belt development directly from the inspection of the premises of the industry and then take a decision for further processing of the proposal.

2. Regarding CSR, the proponent informed that they made contribution to the Prime Minister's Relief Fund (Rs. 17 Lakhs). However, the SEAC ascertained that no effective CSR activities have been carried out as part of this industry. This point also needed to be discussed with the project proponent during the inspection.

Accordingly, the SEAC decided to make an inspection and based on the outcome of the inspection, SEAC will take a decision regarding the grant of EC to the industry.

Accordingly a Technical Team was constituted by the Chairman, SEAC to inspect the project site and submit a Report. The technical team comprised of the following members:

The technical team inspected the site on 09.12.2017 and submitted a report on 10.12.2017. The technical team, based on the site inspection and discussion with the proponent at the site has requested the proponent to furnish additional particulars/proposals. Accordingly, the proponent has submitted the additional particulars/proposals to the technical team on 10.12.2017. After the perusal of the additional particulars/proposals, the technical team decided to recommend the proposal for the grant of Environmental Clearance to SEAC. The Committee has listed the following observations/conditions in its report:

- 1. Green belt development
 - a) At present there are only 16 Trees. Moreover more ornamental trees have been planted under Green belt.
 As there is deficiency, the proponent has committed for planting five more trees within the campus to justify 0.12 Acres area.
 - b) As per the current norms 0.66 Acres (0.26 Ha) should be under Green belt development. A total of 104 Trees should have been planted. At present only 16 Trees are counted. The deficiency is 88 Trees. The Trees planted around the compound wall outside the premises is 98 Trees, which balances the deficiency. They should take care to avoid planting of trees beneath electric power lines.
 - c) As additional Green belt development, the proponent has given a proposal to plant 100 Trees of local species in the nearby Adi Dravida welfare school, Alathur. This should be completed within a period of 1 month and submit the report.
 - 2. Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)
 - As per the details furnished by the proponent, the following are the funds already earmarked for CSR activities:
