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<b>Agenda No. 75- A</b>	<b>Online processing of EC/TOR applications &amp; other Issues.</b>
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- a) The MoEF&CC launched the portal for online processing of applications of Category 'B' projects filed by the Project Proponents for Environmental Clearance(EC)/Terms of Reference (TOR) in July, 2015. The SEIAA, A.P is accepting and processing the applications. During online processing a system generated acceptance letter is being sent to the Project Proponents after acceptance by SEIAA, informing to submit the HARD COPY duly signed by the Project Proponent to the SEIAA Office.

The SEAC, A. P., after detailed discussions recommended the following:

The Project Proponent (PP) shall file the applications for EC/TOR through online only. The Project Proponent, after receipt of system generated acceptance letter, shall submit ONE SIGNED HARD COPY to the SEIAA Office immediately by Post / by person.

- b) The PP would also be advised to visit MoEF&CC's site about schedule of SEAC meetings and in case their proposal is listed in the agenda of any SEAC meeting, they should submit the hard copies of the concerned documents (By Post only) to the Secretary-SEAC of PCB, A.P within a week of hosting of meeting notice on Ministry's website.
- c) The proponents, for whom EC was rejected due to violation of Environment (Protection) Act, submitted a representation addressed to the Chairman, SEIAA and the issue was discussed by SEAC. It is resolved to recommend that the State Government may be reminded to expedite the credible action reports, which were referred earlier.
- d) On the request of the Director of Mines of Department of Mines & Geology, AP State Govt., the SEAC obliged to interact with the DDs and ADs of various districts i.e. West Godavari, East Godavari, Visakhapatnam, Vizianagaram & Srikakulam on handling sand reaches. They are informed the mode of preparation of mining plans and EMP of sand reaches. They are advised to prepare on their own and to save the money for Government. The SEAC also advised them to prepare the mapping of the mining plans and leases, during issue of mining permissions and plans such that identification of cluster formation, presence of forest areas or sanctuary areas and other desirable data can be comfortably done. On-line display of the said mapping is also suggested. It was also clarified the procedure for EC, CFE, CFO etc. under various Environmental Acts.
- e) The issue of policy to be adopted for transfer of EC of mining plan from one proponent to the other is discussed on the suggestion of the Chairman of SEIAA. It is resolved to recommend as follows: If an EC for mining is given for a proponent and subsequently due to certain reasons the Mining Dept of Govt. of AP had cancelled the mining lease and later allotted the same mine to the other proponent, EC can be transferred to the second proponent for the period of validity of the already issued EC. This can be done without any requirement of NOC from the first proponent as the first proponent lost his ownership of the mine.
