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- c) The project is proposed at Sy.No.1238 [part] & 1239 [part] Plot No-67 in YSRJ MIH Kopparthy-Ph-I [APIIC], Ambavaram (V), Vallur (M), YSR Kadapa District for which APIIC has not obtained Environmental clearance till now.
- d) The SEAC committee noted the MoEF&CC, GoI, notification S.O. No. 1223(E), dated 27.03.2020 and MoEF&CC Office Memorandum dated 13.04.2020, wherein "All proposals for projects or activities in respect of Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (API), received up to the 30th September 2020, shall be appraised, as Category 'B2' projects provided that any subsequent amendment or expansion or change in product mix, after the 30th September 2020, shall be considered as per the provisions in force at that time."
- e) Further, MoEF&CC, Gol has extended the time specified vide S.O. No. 3636(E), dated 15.10.2020 and last extension was issued upto 31.12.2021 vide S.O.2859(E) dt 16.07.2021. The extract of the notification is as follows:

- a) The Department of Mines and Geology submitted DSR of erstwhile VisakhapatnamDistrict and the same is reviewed in the SEAC meeting. The SEAC noted that the mineral content is available in the nearby village /cluster to the subject mine.
- b) This is an existing lease and the project proponent has obtained Environmental clearance vide order dt.29.03.2022 and the same is valid up to 31.03.2023 and the same was expired on 31.03.2023 and the project proponent obtained 1st renewal Letter of Intent (LOI) from Department of Mines and Geology vide order dt.14.08.2023 for a period of 10 years subject to submission of Approved Mining Plan, EC and CFE and now project proponent has applied for fresh Environmental clearance.
- c) The Committee noted that as per the cluster letter issued by the District Mines &Geology Officer, (FAC)Anakapalli, vide Letter dated: 16.11.2023, there are 23 existing quarry leases within the radius of 500 mtrs area. The total cluster area is < 5.0 Ha.
- d) As per the approved mining plan dt.10.10.2023, the total provided mineral reserves are 1,86,569m³. The proponent proposed to excavate – 35,000 m³/annum and Life of the mine is 5.33 years. The project proponent submitted approved mining plan as per the NGT norms duly ear-marking 0.3848 Ha (200m) as a non-mining zone towards habitation side

e) The project proponent allocated Rs. 4.6 Lakhs as capital cost and Rs. 4.80 Lakhs as a recurring cost budget for the EMP. The proponent volunteered to provide Water Treatment Plant to Kunchangi SC colonyas a part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activity and shall maintain till the life of the mine. Also, the project proponent has proposed to provide scholarships to students of Kunchangi village.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, mining plan, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to issueEnvironmental Clearance for mining of Road metal and building stone - 35,000 m³/annum with following conditions:

 The project proponent shall comply with the proposals furnished in the Environmental management plan.

 The project proponent shall develop greenbelt of 1km along approach roads & village Roadsides.

The project proponent shall maintain 7.5mt greenbelt in buffer zone and existing buffer zone plantation should not be disturbed.

 The proponent shall take dust suppression measures to meet the CPCB stipulated ambient air quality standards at any point of time.

The proponent shall carryout suppression of dust generated due to transport vehicles by continuous water spraying using tankers.

The vehicles carrying the mines material shall be covered with tarpaulin during vehicular movement.

The project proponent shall not use village road/ canal bund roads for mineral transportation purpose.

 The project proponent shall restrict vehicles movement during the peak hours to avoid accidents.

The project proponent shall maintain village road along with the cluster partners.

10. The project proponent shall avoid over loading of material in trucks.

 The project proponent shall adopt for controlled blasting as the habitation is about 164m.
