

1. Revision and Expansion of "Sharda Institutional Area" including 1200 bedded at Plot No.-32 and 34, Knowledge Park- III, Greater Noida, District-Gautam Budh Nagar, U.P., M/s Sharda Education Trust. File No. 5081/4868/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/42222/2019

In view of the Hon'ble NGT order passed in O.A. no. 1038/2018 dated 14/11/2019 (corrected on 19/11/2019) SEIAA opined that the case would be reviewed later and decision would be taken after receiving clarification from MoEF&CC.

2. Expansion of "Omaxe Integrated Township" at Village-Sarsawan, Sultanpur Road, Lucknow., M/s OMAX Ltd. File No. 5082/4602/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/41817/2018

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 2- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.

- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
- 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
- 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
- 6- The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharged. Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be reused or discharged to municipal sewer line.
- 7- The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
- 8- The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
- 9- The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.

SEIAA noted that SEAC has deferred the matter for next meeting due to paucity of time. SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC.


17. OA NO. 474/2019 Surendra Singh Vs MOEFCC & Others


SEIAA gone through the comments of SEAC and also minutes of Joint meeting held on 23/10/2019. SEIAA found that in joint meeting two issues were discussed and decided (i) To revoke 18 EC in compliance to Hon'ble NGT order dated 13/09/2019 in O.A. no- 186 of 2016: Satyendra Pandey Vs MoEF&Cc and other and (ii) to revoke 36 EC in compliance to Hon'ble NGT order dated 25/09/2019 in appeal no- 263 of 2018 and with appeal no- 264 of 2018: Ami Upadhyay Vs State level Environment Impact Assessment Authority and others. Nodal officer SEIAA informed that all these 54 ECs have been revoked and communicated to Project proponent and all concerned. SEIAA opined to refer the matter to SEAC in case any other further action is to be taken.


