

#### Agenda-C: Minutes of 503<sup>rd</sup> SEAC Meeting Dated 23/11/2020

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to send a letter to District Magistrate, Saharanpur along with complaint letter dated 16/10/2020 with the remarks "please dispose the complaint and also inform the committee about the outcome. The copy of letter should be sent to the Directorate, Geology and Mining, Lucknow and complainant for information and necessary action.

1. Sand/Morrum Mining from Betwa River Bed at Gata No.- 321 Ga, Village- Salemapur, Tehsil- Moth, District-Jhansi, U.P., Smt. Shashi Devi., M/s Shubh Construction., Area-10.0 ha. File No. 5915/5489/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/57175/2020

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant Environmental Clearance to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that the geo-coordinates for which EC has been recommended are different from geo-coordinates submitted on the verified map by project proponent. Hence SEIAA opined that project proponent shall submit the clarification of the above along with the relevant documents.



2. Sand Mining Project at Gata No.-392/1, Village- Barua Aehatmalisi, Tehsil- Rajapur, District-Chitrakoot, U.P. Shri Akhilesh Kumar, M/s Kashi Construction Company ., Area- 17.71 Ha. File No. 5937/4912/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/57294/2019

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant Environmental Clearance to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and letter of DM Chitrakoot letter no. 1415/Khanij/2019-20 dated 25.07.2019 clarifying the area of the project. SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC adding following specific condition as follows:-

1. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
2. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.
3. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
4. SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC that the matter shall be discussed after submission of online information on prescribed portal.

5. Sand/Morrum Mining along Ken River Bed in Khanda No.- BA-1,Gata No.- 43 mi, 44 mi, Village- Bara, Tehsil- Bindki, District- Fatehpur, U.P., M/s Shreebamdev Global Pvt. Ltd., Area-7.13 Ha. File No. 5966/5314/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/57926/2019

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC adding following specific condition as follows:-

1. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
2. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.


SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC that the matter shall be discussed after submission of online information on prescribed portal.




