	<p>The Proponent, M/s. SPR Construction Pvt. Ltd has applied for Environmental Clearance for the proposed Construction of Residential Building complex with a built up area of 55,022 Sq.m at R.S. Nos: 204/1, 204/2, 204/3, 205 Block No. 10 of Perambur Town, R.S. No: 2279/2, Block No. 36, R. S. No. 2803, Block no. 42 of Purasawalkam Town, Division 73, Zone VI, Greater Chennai Corporation, Perambur village, Purasawalkam-Perambur Taluk, Chennai District ,Tamilnadu on 25.09.2017.</p> <p>The proposal was placed in the 99th meeting held on 11.12.2017. Based on the presentation made by the proponent and the documents furnished, the SEAC decided to recommend the proposal for grant of EC to SEIAA subject to usual condition after obtaining the following details:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The proponent submits that CMWSSB will be the source of water supply. It is proposed to use the nearby sewer line for the disposal of sewage. The proponent should check the adequacy in terms of water supply and sewage disposal.</li><li>2. The proponent should check the rain water harvesting proposals as it is found that soil contains clay upto 24m.</li><li>3. The project should not pollute Otteri Nallah in any way.</li></ol>
