In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC, SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

- 1- The project proponent shall submit approved building plans within the 1 month.
- 2- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 3- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leaf trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
- 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same like water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems. At least one school in the vicinity of project area should be provided with rooftop solar plant, toilets in public place or in school of nearby villages and if there is a girl's school then girls toilet properly equipped with overhead water tank should be constructed.
- 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
- 6- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.

12. "Ordinary Earth Mine", at Gata No.- 1140, Village- Achkamau, Tehsil- Haidergarh, District- Barabanki, Shri Mohammad Irfan, Area- 0.396 Ha., 8565/SIA/UP/MIN/454557/2023.

SEIAA opined to accept the recommendation of SEAC and grant EC to the said project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by SEAC taking into consideration discussion held in SEIAA meeting no. 597 dated 05.05.2022 regarding reply of SEAC-1 and SEAC-2 for compliance/action taken on TOR/Public hearing, **but EC will be issued only after the submission of original notarized agreement between land owner and lease holder**, adding following specific conditions:-

1. If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate.
2. Validity period of this EC is 3 months from the date of issue as the Lol has been issued for a period of 3 months or co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier. After this period the EC will become null and void.
3. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Van Sanrakshan evam Samvardhan Adhiniyam, 2023 and submit before the start of work.
4. The mining lease holders shall ensure to comply with mine reclamation plan as submitted
5. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
6. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or district plantation committee, for planting at least 1,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.

The project proponent shall ensure that water bodies do not get polluted due to mining activity and in consultation with District Environment Authority or an Authority nominated by concerned DM, project proponent will prepare a conservation and management plan for rejuvenation and management of all water bodies within periphery of 5 km. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six monthly compliance status will be presented by project proponent before the nominated authority in the District.

15. Expansion of Exiting Rolling Mill Plan located at Village- Godni, Pargana- Basahi, Tehsil & District- Bahraich, Shri Sanjay Kumar Jain, M/s Sudhesh Industries Pvt. Ltd., 6991/SIA/UP/IND/307490/2023.
SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to amend the site detail of the project in terms of reference letter dated 12/07/2022 as per above details. All the other contents mentioned in terms of reference letter dated 12/07/2022 shall remain the same.
16. Bhedi Khurd Sand/Morrum Mining Project on Betwa River at Gata No.-1396 G, Khand No.- 05,Village- Bhedi Khurd, Tehsil- Kalpi, District- Jalaun, Uttar Pradesh, Area 20.243 ha., 8571/7632/SIA/UP/MIN/455178/2023.
SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC that the project proponent will submit NOC from Forest Department/competent authority regarding the crocodile habitat. SEIAA may send a letter to DFO, Jalaun in this regard and copy of the letter also send to District Magistrate, Jalaun and DGM, U.P. for information and necessary action.

17. Complaint Letter of Mr. Ashok Kumar & Mr. Karan Singh, dated 23.12.2023 regarding "Complaint against (1) Sh. Bani Singh, Proprietor of M/s New Panther Security Guard Service, (2) Sh. Rajesh Goyal, (3) Sh.
