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### **Minutes of the 579<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) held on 07.04.2022**

The meeting of 579<sup>th</sup> State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) was held on-line on 07.04.2022 at the Directorate of Environment. The following were present in the meeting:-

Nodal Officer SEIAA informed that agenda is prepared by Secretariat and approved by MS SEIAA which is hereby put up for the consideration of SEIAA and placed files and documents related to below mentioned projects before SEIAA.

#### **Agenda-A: -Discussions**

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Satyendra Pandey through Shri Arvind Kumar Rai dated 19.09.2021 regarding E-city Entertainment project received along with GoUP letter no. 204/81-6-2022 dated 16.03.2022 regarding the above subject. SEIAA noted that till date EC has not been granted and the matter is still under consideration of SEIAA. A committee has been formed by MS SEIAA for site visit and the report by the committee is awaited.

2. Seeking revocation and cancellation of four (4) Environmental Clearances in Tehsil-Obra, District- Sonbhadra, UP, by SEIAA UP being situated within critically polluted area (CPA) and also within 5 km of eco-sensitive zone(Kaimur Wild Life Sanctuary)

SEIAA gone through the e-mail dated 25.02.2022 of Shri Vanshdeep Dalmia, AoR, Supreme Court of India regarding the above subject. SEIAA noted that a case in Hon'ble NGT OA no. 231 of 2022 has been filed in. Hence the matter is subjudice in Court.



✓ 3. Stone Mining at Gata No.-4949 Kha, Khand No.-05, Village- Billimarkundi, Tehsil-Obra, District- Sonbhadra, M/s Shri Mahadev Enterprise Area-5.880 ha. File No. 6399/Proposal No. SIA / UP/MIN/64123/2021

SEIAA observed that the above project was taken in its 571<sup>st</sup> meeting in which SEIAA noted that comments from UPPCB regarding CPA. The SEIAA noted that the project proponent has submitted an affidavit regarding CPA that if the project falls within the CPA and prohibited area, project proponent will abide accordingly and apply under category 'A'. Hence SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC-1 to issue additional ToR to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies.

The SEIAA also added the following points to ToR-

- 1- Project Proponent / Consultant has given an affidavit that the project area doesn't fall within the boundary of Critically Polluted Area (CPA). If the affidavit given by PP / Consultant is found to be false then ToR will be deemed to be cancelled. Further, certificate from concerned RO, UPSPCB that area doesn't attract CPA and a copy of the same should be submitted at the time of evaluation of EIA-EMP report by SEAC.
- 2- At the time of EIA submission the project proponent/consultant will also submit compliance of NGT order dated 02/8/2021 in the matter of Appeal No. 54/2020 Anil Kumar Yadav Versus State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Uttar Pradesh & Ors. with Review Application No. 07/2021 in Appeal No. 04/2020 Abhinav Gramodyog & Seva Sansthan Versus State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Uttar Pradesh & Ors.

✓ 4. Stone Mining at Gata No.-7407Ka, Village-Billimarkundi, The.-Obra, District-Sonbhadra., M/s Mahakal Enterprises, Area-1.5300 ha. File No. 6400/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/64121/2021

SEIAA observed that the above project was taken in its 571<sup>st</sup> meeting in which SEIAA noted that comments from UPPCB regarding CPA. The SEIAA noted that the project proponent has submitted an affidavit regarding CPA that if the project falls within the CPA and prohibited area, project proponent will abide accordingly and apply under category 'A'. Hence SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC-1 to issue additional ToR to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies.

The SEIAA also added the following points to ToR-

- 1- Project Proponent / Consultant has given an affidavit that the project area doesn't fall within the boundary of Critically Polluted Area (CPA). If the affidavit given by PP / Consultant is found to be false then ToR will be deemed to be cancelled. Further, certificate from concerned RO, UPSPCB that area doesn't attract CPA and a copy of the same should be submitted at the time of evaluation of EIA-EMP report by SEAC.
- 2- At the time of EIA submission the project proponent/consultant will also submit compliance of NGT order dated 02/8/2021 in the matter of Appeal No. 54/2020 Anil Kumar Yadav Versus State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Uttar Pradesh & Ors. with Review Application No. 07/2021 in Appeal No. 04/2020 Abhinav Gramodyog & Seva Sansthan Versus State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Uttar Pradesh & Ors.





✓ 5. Warehousing Project beside Sohramu Police Station, Hasanganj, Unnao., Shri Rahul Kasawadhen, M/s Sambandh Infrastructure Development LLP. File No. 6499/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/223027/2021

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 574<sup>th</sup> minutes of which should be amended as:-

1.	SEIAA gone through the letter of M/S Sambandh Infrastructure Development dated 02.03.2022 regarding typographical error in the name of the District mentioned in MoM of 591 SEAC-1 meeting. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that according to application made correction should be made in the District which should be Unnao.	SEIAA gone through the letter of M/S Sambandh Infrastructure Development dated 02.03.2022 regarding typographical error in the name of the District mentioned in MoM of 591 SEAC-1 meeting. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that according to application made correction should be made in the District which should be Unnao and agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to grant EC to the above project adding the following conditions:-

- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 2- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leaf trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
- 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
- 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
- 6- The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharge.
- 7- Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be discharged to municipal sewer line.
- 8- The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
- 9- The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.



- 10- A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
- 11- If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
- 12- Provision for charging of electric vehicles as per the guidelines of GoI / GoUP should be submitted within the next 3 months.

1. **Proposed Commercial Project "Platinum Mall" at Plot No. T-6, IBB-2, Shushant Golf City, Lucknow, UP. M/s Platinum Mall Private Limited. File No. 6590/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/67763/2021**

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 550<sup>th</sup> Meeting in which SEIAA deferred the project in light of MoEFCC directions regarding violation cases. The project proponent has submitted a letter dated 28.02.2022. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that as per the site photograph and presentation it seems that the project is still under construction and cost incurred is 89.92 crores whereas as per the CA certificate the total project cost is 89.92 crores. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent should submit the cost incurred as on date from the authorized valuer, clarification regarding difference in plot area in registry and SEAC minutes

- ✓ 1. **Soil Excavation at Gata No.- 88, 89, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 100, 101, 102 & 125, Village-Manpur Mujjaffarpur, Tehsil-Kanth Moradabad., Area 2.839 Ha. File No. 6735/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/240499/2021**

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 570<sup>th</sup> Meeting in which SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit legible certified lease map with geo-coordinates. The project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 14.03.2022. After reviewing the reply SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC 612<sup>th</sup> meeting to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific condition regarding cluster certificate as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate" and adding following conditions:-



1. Validity period of this EC is co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier.
  2. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
  3. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
  4. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
  5. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 3,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.
  6. In consultation with District Environment Authority or an Authority nominated by concerned DM, project proponent will prepared a conservation and management plan for rejuvenation and management of water bodies having total surface area of more than 15 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six monthly compliance status will be presented by project proponent before the nominated authority in the District.
  7. Department of Geology and Mines, Government of Uttar Pradesh and / or concerned district administration, before releasing the security deposit to Project Proponent will ensure that Project Proponent has fully complied with the EC conditions. Non-compliance, if any, should be reported to UPSPCB for appropriate legal action and recovery of compensation.
  8. Any application for transfer of this EC, during its validity period unless it is cancelled by a competent authority, has to be necessarily accompanied with status of compliance of EC conditions duly certified by IRO, MoEFCC, GoI, Lucknow.
2. Affordable (PMAY) Housing Project "Aradhyam" (Plot No.- A,B & C)" at Khasra No.- 291 M, 290 M, 294M, 332, 337, 338, 339, 358M, 462M, 493M, at Village- Pasonda, Ghaziabad, Shri Vijay Kumar., M/s Aradhyam Builders. File No. 6614/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/233015/2021

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 550<sup>th</sup> Meeting in which SEIAA opined that project proponent shall submit Details regarding final discharge point, permission of discharge in sewer and the carrying capacity of the sewer, PP should explain the source of water used during the construction period. The project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 28.02.2022. After reviewing the



reply SEIAA found that the reply is in-complete/ unsatisfactory. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit complete reply.

3. Group Housing "Grand Forte Apartments" at Plot NO.-76, Sigma-IV, Greater Noida, Shri Vishnu Lalwani, M/s Satilila Sahkari Awas Samti. File No. 6350/6155/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/215063/2021

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 550<sup>th</sup> Meeting in which SEIAA deferred the project in light of MoEFCC directions regarding violation cases. The project proponent has submitted a letter dated 28.02.2022. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that the above violation project was submitted to SCIAA UP beyond violation window. Hence SEIAA opined that the matter shall be referred back to SEAC for review and clearly mentioning the reason to appraise the project when it was applied in SEIAA UP beyond violation window.

- ✓ 4. Hotel Project at Plot No.- TC-25 V & 26 V, VibhutiKhand, Gomti Nagar, District-Lucknow, U.P. M/s Luxus Hospitality Pvt.Ltd.File No. 6509 Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/ 66785/2021

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 563<sup>rd</sup> meeting in which SEIAA opined to take up the project in next SEIAA meeting. This project has operated in violation without seeking EC under MoEF, GoI Notification S.O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006. SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue additional ToR to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies under the provisions of MoEFCC, GoI vide OM no. 22-21/2020-IA.III dated 07.07.2021 which has laid down Standard Operating Procedure (SoP) for Identification and handling of violation cases. SEIAA also added the following points to ToR-

1. The State Government/SPCB to take action against the project proponent under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and further no consent to operate to be issued till the project is granted EC.
2. Direction to be issued under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to stop the violating activities till the EC is obtained.
3. The project proponent shall be required to submit a bank guarantee equivalent to the amount of remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan with the SPCB prior to the grant of EC. The quantum shall be recommended by the EAC and finalized by the regulatory authority. The bank guarantee shall be released after successful implementation of the FMP, followed by recommendations of the FAC and approval of the regulatory authority.
4. Assessment of ecological damage with respect to air, water, land and other environmental attributes. The collection and analysis of data shall be done by an environmental laboratory duly notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, or an environmental laboratory accredited by NABL, or a laboratory of a Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR).
5. Preparation of EMP comprising remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan corresponding to the ecological damage assessed and economic benefits derived due to violation.
6. The remediation plan and the natural and community resource augmentation plan to be prepared as an independent chapter (13) in the EIA report by the





accredited consultants.

7. Budget of remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan corresponding to the ecological damage shall be completed within three years and to be prepared accordingly.
8. All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
9. Copy of all the analysis reports duly signed by analyst approved by NABL or MoEF&CC shall be annexed with the EIA report and original analysis reports should be presented at the time of presentation.
10. MOU signed between the project proponent and the consultant should be submitted.
11. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit along with EIA.
12. Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).
13. Provision for charging of electric vehicles as per the guidelines of GoI / GoUP should be submitted.
14. SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit permission of CGWA or proposal for alternative source of fresh water.

✓ 5. Transfer of EC of Sand/ Morrum Mining from river bed of Yamuna, at Zone No./Gata No./ Khand No.-11/15 and 11/16 at Village- Diya Uparhar, Tehsil- Manjhanpur, District- Kaushambi, U.P. (L. Area-24.28 Ha) M/s Rishab Herbal Pvt Ltd. File No. 4045/Proposal No. (SIA/UP/MIN/72559/2018)

SEIAA noted that the above matter was discussed in its 532<sup>nd</sup> meeting in which SEIAA opined that Legal notice dated 10.08.2021 of Shri Vansdeep Dalmia AOR Supreme Court of India shall be referred to DM, Kaushambi for factual report. SEIAA reviewed the notice and found that matter relates to previously cancelled 18 ECs by SEIAA UP. The above EC was not included. Hence SEIAA opined that Environmental Clearance will be transferred only after submission of an affidavit by project proponent and consultant that:-

- a) No legal case is pending in any Court of Law against the above area / EC proposed to be transferred.
- b) EC proposed to be transferred has not been cancelled by any Court of Law/MoEFCC/SEIAA/DEIAA.
- c) EC proposed to be transferred is valid on the date of consideration.

SEIAA gone through the letter of Manali Vintrade Pvt. Ltd. dated 23.03.2022 regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 281/Parya/SEAC/4045/2018 date 31.03.2018. SEIAA gone through file and documents and noted that the Environmental Clearance was issued to Shri Arun Kumar S/o Shri Ram Vilash Singh, R/o A1/123DLF Dilshad Vistar 2 Sahibabad Pasaunda Ghaziabad. SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Arun Kumar was cancelled vide DM, Kaushambi order no. 786/khanij-Ka dated 20.10.2020 and another LOI was issued to M/s Manali Vintrade Pvt. Ltd., prop. Shri Shafiqua Mohd. S/o Shri Mohd. Chhiddu R/o 259 pur, Kanpur Dehat vide letter no. 315/Khanij-ko dated 24.07.2021 for a period of 6 months. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no.



281/Parya/SEAC/4045/2018 date 31.03.2018 from Shri Arun Kumar S/o Shri Ram Vilash Singh, R/o A1/123DLF Dilshad Vistar 2 Sahibabad Pasaunda Ghaziabad to M/s Manali Vintrade Pvt. Ltd., prop. Shri Shafiqua Mohd. S/o Shri Mohd. Chhiddu R/o 259 pur, Kanpur Dehat for six months and 1,80,000 m<sup>3</sup> capacity, with the condition that the EC will not be transferred further and after 6 months the EC will be null and void. SEIAA added the following conditions:-

1. Validity period of this EC is co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier.
2. For seeking any extension in transfer period or re-transfer, PP shall submit fresh annual replenishment study to SEIAA, UP for amendment in EC for mineable quantity and maximum permissible depth for mining based on scientific findings of replenishment study. Such study shall be placed before SEAC for appraisal.
3. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
4. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
5. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.

Department of Geology and Mines, Government of Uttar Pradesh and / or concerned district administration, before releasing the security deposit to Project Proponent will ensure that Project Proponent has fully complied with the EC conditions. Non-compliance, if any, should be reported to UPSPCB for appropriate legal action and recovery of compensation.

Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 281/Parya/SEAC/4045/2018 date 31.03.2018 shall remain same.

Hence SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue additional ToRs to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. Tor will be issued only after the project proponent submits an affidavit stating that-

- 9- Status of leases granted/to be granted in various mining khands along with production since the formulation of DSR, duly certified by the competent authority should be submitted.
- 10- In case project proponent intends to temporarily store mined out material or any tools, equipments or other material outside mine lease area then NOC from competent authority for doing so should be submitted and details of such area and associated Environmental impacts should be included in EIA-EMP report. This should also be clearly mentioned during public hearing.

- 12- Observations raised in public hearing, replies submitted by project proponent, suitable modifications carried out in EIA-EMP report.
- 13- Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 1,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants below Uttar Pradesh Forest Department's survival rate will be treated as violation of EC condition.
- 14- In consultation with District Environment Authority or an authority nominated by concerned DM, Project Proponent will prepare a conservation and management plan for the rejuvenation and management of water bodies having a total surface area of not less than 5 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six-monthly implementation status will be presented by the Project Proponent before the nominated authority in the district.
- 15- Along with the EIA-EMP report, PP / consultant will also submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed entire ToR while preparing draft EIA-EMP report for PH. Further, PP / consultant will submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed issues raised during public hearing and have incorporated the same in final EIA-EMP report.
