The SEIAA discussed in detail and based on the recommendations of SEAC, the proponent has submitted an undertaking dt: 06.08.2024 in compliance with the DFO, Mahabubnagar letter dt: 06.06.2023, duly maintaining buffer of 50 meters distance from the nearest RF boundary from the proposed quarry site and accordingly, also furnished the revised map (maintaining buffer of 50 meters), signed & approved by the DDMG, Hyderabad dt: 15.09.2023. Hence, approved the project for issue of Environmental Clearance subject to submission of total project cost clearly indicating the EMP cost, duly certified by Chartered Accountant (CA).
