3) Miscellaneous Matters: -

- Authority deliberated the previous compliance reports of Soapstone mining in Bageshwar and it was decided to request D.M. Bageshwar to review compliance of the stipulted conditions of ECs.
- Comments on Six monthly Compliance Reports of two Mining proposals of Forest Development Corporation of Uttarakhand (UKFDC)-

These were discussed and it was decided to seek comments of UKFDC as per comments below:

I- Dabka River Mining Project in District Nanital, Uttarakhand

Divisional Manager (Mining) Forest Corporation of Uttarakhand vide its letter dated 21.11.2019 has submitted the Six-monthly Compliance Report (April 2019 to September 2019) for Dabka River Mining Project in District Nanital, Uttarakhand to Regional Office MOEF&CC, Dehradun and a copy has also been sent to SEIAA for information and necessary action.

After going through, the Six-monthly Compliance Report, following points have been observed: -

1. Environmental Clearance for Dabka River Mining project in District Nanital, Uttarakhand was accorded by MOEF&CC GOI, New Delhi vide its letter No J-11015/359/2009-IA. II (M) dated 15th April 2011.

2. The Forest Clearance was obtained vide letter no 8-61/1999-FC (pt-II) dated 15.02.2013 for 10 years and copy of the same is enclosed with the Compliance Report.

3. Consent to operate has been obtained from UEPPCB by Letter No UEPPCB /HO/Con/U-86/2019 /2023 dated 05.03.2019(copy enclosed with the C.R).

4. Under the condition No (iv) of Environment Clearance letter of MoEF&CC, requisite prior clearance from Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife was to be obtained by the project proponent because location of Jim Corbett National Park is in the buffer zone of mine and location of Shivalik Elephant Reserve is within the core zone and buffer zone of the mine. All the conditions stipulated by the Standing Committee shall have to be effectively implemented.

The project was discussed by the Standing Committee of NBWL on March 20th 2013 (Copy of minutes enclosed with the Compliance Report at Annexure III) wherein Member Secretary informed that the proposal was 10.71kms. Away from Corbett Tiger Reserve and has been recommended by the State Board for Wildlife. One expert was of the view that though the project is outside of the jurisdiction of the Standing Committee of NBWL, this proposal requires to be discussed due to the fact that it lies in the prime tiger habitat and therefore should not be permitted. The committee therefore decided to adopt a special resolution to be conveyed to the State Government that work of mining of minor minerals from Dabka, Nanital must not be pursued on ecological considerations.

From above it appears that the proposal of Dabka River Mining was not agreed upon by the Standing Committee of NBWL on the basis of ecological considerations.

- 5. Project proponent has submitted a letter dated 08.12.210 of Chief Wildlife Warden Uttarakhand vide which he has issued No Objection Certificate with reference to Environment Clearance Letter dated 3.12.2010 for six mining proposals wherein Dabka river mine is mentioned at Serial No 3. Actually, the Environmental Clearance for Dabka River Mining project in District Nanital, Uttarakhand was accorded by MOEF&CC GOI, New Delhi vide its letter No J-11015/359/2009-IA. II(M) dated 15th April 2011. So, it's not understood how NOC was issued to the project in year 2010 by the State Wildlife Warden.
- The Standing Committee meeting of NBWL was held on 20th March 2013 and its minutes have been released vide letter dated 27.05.2013 and No objection certificate of



Chief Wildlife Warden was issued prior to this on December 8th 2010(Copy enclosed in CR).

7. The MOEF&CC Environment Clearance letter condition no (vi) says the clearance is subject to obtaining Wildlife Clearance from the competent Authority. If further clearance was obtained then the same may be informed and documents may be submitted.

8. Plantation has said to be undertaken by forest department for which the project proponent (UKFDC) has deposited Rs 90,21,229 with the State Forest department. It's not clear from the letter that the amount mentioned, is for Dabka mine or for Dabka and Kosi mines or for all the mines in that region. This should be clarified and photographs of the plantation area along with name and number of species planted against Dabka mining project be submitted. Name of the range where this degraded area has been selected for plantation should also be informed.

9. Letter from CMO of Health department, wherein the dates of Health Check camps

along with the financial expenditure incurred may be submitted.

10. Photographs of the temporary rest shelters and first aid facilities constructed for labourers has to be submitted.

11. The progress of Digital Processing of the entire lease area the progress of the same

may be intimated.

12. As per the Point No (xix) of EC precautionary measures were to be taken for conservation and protection of endangered flora and fauna during the mining operation in that area for which Action plan for conservation was to be prepared in consultation with

the State Forest and Wildlife Department.

With reference to above it has been mentioned by the project proponent in the compliance report that there are no such types of species found in the nearby area. But if any such species are found then precautionary measures will be taken for conservation. It is worth mentioning here that as per the minutes of Standing Committee meeting of NBWL held on 20th March 2013 the project lies in the prime tiger habitat. As per the condition No (iv) of Environment Clearance the location of Jim Corbett National Park is in the buffer zone of mine and location of Shivalik Elephant Reserve within the core zone and buffer zone of the mine. The condition for conservation of flora and fauna in the EC is usually prescribed after thorough examination/ discussion of the proposal by the members of Environmental Appraisal Committee of MoEF&CC. So, Action plan for conservation is required to be prepared and financial provisions may be made as per the condition in consultation with the Wildlife wing and be submitted.

13. Photographs of the four Ambient Air Quality monitoring stations selected by the project

proponent may be submitted.

14. Environment Management Cell has been formed for all the rivers falling in Reserve forests in Uttarakhand wherein for mining of minor minerals the Environment Clearance has been obtained and Annexed as Annexure XI. The duties of this cell should be specified and financial provision for implementation of Environmental safe guards/conditions be earmarked.

II-Kosi River Mining Project in District Nanital, Uttarakhand

Divisonal Manager (Mining) Forest Corporation of Uttarakhand vide its letter dated 21.11.2019 has submitted the Six-monthly Compliance Report (April 2019 to September 2019) of Kosi River Mining Project in District Nanital, Uttarakhand to Regional Office MOEF&CC, Dehradun and a copy has also been sent to SEIAA for information and necessary action. After going through the, six monthly Compliance Report, the following points have been observed: -

(i) Environmental Clearance for Kosi River Mining project in District Nanital, Uttarakhand was accorded by MOEF&CC GOI, New Delhi vide its letter No J-11015/360/2009-IA. II(M) dated 13th April 2011.

(ii) The Forest Clearance was obtained vide letter no 8-61/1999-FC (pt-I) dated 15.02.2013 for 10 years and copy of the same is annexed as Annexure- IA with the Compliance Report.

(iii) Consent to operate has been obtained from UEPPCB vide Letter No 39152 Env

Cell 2019-20 dated 12.09.2018 (copy enclosed as Annexure –I in CR).

(iv) Under the condition No (iv)of Environment Clearance letter of MoEF&CC, requisite prior clearance from Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife was to be obtained by the project proponent because location of Jim Corbett National Park in the buffer zone of mine and location of Shivalik Elephant Reserve within the core zone and buffer zone of the mine. All the conditions stipulated by the Standing Committee shall have to be effectively implemented.

The project was discussed by the Standing Committee of NBWL on March 20th of 2013 (Copy enclosed with the Compliance Report at Annexure III) wherein Member Secretary informed that the proposal has been recommended by the State Board for Wildlife. One expert was of the view that the state would make efforts to revive the crucial Gola Corridor and for this a monitoring committee be constituted by Centre and State governments. After discussion, the committee agreed to the suggestion of committee member and decided to recommend the proposal subject to such conditions



as may be prescribed by the State Chief Wildlife Warden and centre would work out with the State Government to take efforts to protect the Gola corridor and constitution of Committee.

- (v) Plantation has said to be undertaken by forest department for which the project proponent (UKFDC) has deposited Rs 90,21,229 with the State Forest department. It's not clear from the letter that the amount mentioned, is for Dabka mine or for Dabka and Kosi mines or for all the mines in that region. This should be clarified and photographs of the plantation area along with name and number of species planted against Kosl mine project be submitted. Name of the range where this degraded area has been selected for plantation should also be informed.
- (vi) Letter from CMO of Health department, wherein the dates of Health Check camps along with the financial expenditure incurred may be submitted.
- (vii) Photographs of the temporary rest shelters and first aid facilities for labours to be submitted.
- The progress of Digital processing of the entire lease area may be informed.
- (ix) As per the Point No (xix) of EC precautionary measures were to be taken for conservation and protection of endangered flora and fauna during the mining operation in that area for which Action plan for conservation was to be prepared in consultation with the State Forest and Wildlife Department.

With reference to above it has been informed by the project proponent in the compliance report that there are no such types of species found in the nearby area. But if any such species are found then precautionary measures will be taken for conservation. It has been mentioned in the condition that location of Jim Corbett National Park is in the buffer zone of the mine and Shivalik Elephant Reserve is within the core zone and buffer zone of the mine. The condition for conservation of flora and fauna in the EC is usually prescribed after thorough examination/ discussion of the proposal by the members of Environmental Appraisal Committee of MOEF&CC. So, Action Plan along with the financial provisions for conservation measures is required to be prepared as per the condition in consultation with the Wildlife Division and submitted.

- (x) Photographs of the four Ambient Air Quality monitoring stations selected by the
- project proponent may be submitted. (xi) Environment Management Cell has been formed for all the rivers falling in Reserve forests in Uttarakhand wherein for mining of minor minerals, Environment Clearance has been obtained and Annexed as Annexure XI. The duties of this cell should be specified and financial provision for implementation of Environmental safe guards/conditions be earmarked.
- 3) Authority considered the request letter of Additional Chief Secretary, Mining submitted vide letter No-659/VII-A-1/2020/5(11)20 DATED 16-06-2020. The matter was discussed in the meeting and and it was decided that it is not possibe to extend the mining period of mining during monson season as per The Indian Meteorogical Department, Nagpur letter no-NAGPUR RMC/CS-312 dated 18th January, 2016 as indicated in Sustainable Sand Mining Guidelines-2016 and Enforcement and Monitoring Guidline for Sand Mining-2020.
- 4) The Authority considered the letter of Director Geology, Mining submitted vide letter No-17 Muk/141/Bage/Khanan/Bhu/Khni/E/2010-11/2019. The matter was discussed in the meeting and and it was decided that EC should be revised accordingly. However, before revised EC is issued, satisfactory compliance reports may be obtained, if mining has been started.

4) Environmental Clearance for Proposed Installation of Hot Mix Plant at Khata No. 00865, Khasra No. 287 Ka, Khata No. 00703, Khasra No. 287 Kha, Khata No. 00121, Khasra No. 287 Ga, Khata No. 00996, Khasra No. 286 Ka, Village - Chharba, Pargana Pachwadoon, Tehsil - Vikasnagar, District - Dehradun By M/s R. K. Handa, 1/22/1, Prem Nagar, Dehradun.

The Authority decided to accept the recommendations of SEAC for grant of temporary EC to the project proponent for installation of Hot Mix Plant and DG Set for period of one year and subject to submission of revised CER. Installation of wet scrubers will form part of additional EC conditions.

5) Environmental Clearance for Manufacturing of Custom Organic Molecules for Research and Development at Plot No. 13, Sector-3A, SIDCUL, IIE, Haridwar, By M/s POI India Biotech Pvt. Ltd.

The Authority decided to defer the matter.
