Reply furnished by the proponent:

Sri Ramesh Rothu, Authorised representative of the mine:

1. He thanked all the villagers for gathering and expressing their views. They will carryout quarry operations without any impact on the surrounding villages and with the consents of the surrounding villages. If the area needs to be development, industries have to come. The industries will generate revenue and pay taxes to the government in various forms, and simultaneously be useful to the locals. The industry will provide direct and indirect employment.
2. If this quarry is established, they will pay one crore per year an average to the government. The funds generated in the form of the district mineral fund (DMF) will be utilized for the development of local areas such as roads school, etc., he said that they will provide training for skill development to villagers so that they can have employment based on their capabilities.
3. He said that some of the villager expressed concern that if the quarry is opened, the surrounding lands will be affected. In this regard, he clarified that they will not conduct quarry operations by affecting the surrounding farmers: he knows the difficulty of the farmers as he also belong the farmer family. He further said that the quarry will be operated with all government permissions and duly following the conditions stipulated by the MOEF&CC and PCB and assured that if any damage occurs due to the operations of the quarry to surrounding land and farmers, they will take the responsibility and compensate them.
4. He emphasized the development taking place in the tekkali area by the granite quarries, and he further stressed that the mine will be operated in accordance with all procedures and regulations. He explained the royalties being paid by the quarries to the government. He said that dust will be controlled by water sprinkling, and if any roads are damaged, that will be rectified. CSR funds will be allocated as per the rules to conduct health camps and provide water plants, ect in the surrounding villages. The establishment of quarries will prevent the migration of people from this region. He asked the public for their support to carry mining operations.

The proponent volunteered to allocate water treatment plant to **Bellukola** Village as a part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activity.
