


Agenda-A: -Complaints/letters –

1. 100 KLPD (60 KLPD Molasses and 40 KLPD Grain) Multi feed Distillery at Gata No.-135, 139,140, 141,142, 143,145,153, 154,155, 156,157, 1, Village-Aurangabad, Tehsil-Nawabganj, Bareilly, U.P., M/s Oswal Overseas Ltd. File No. 5053/Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND2/ 42553/2019

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 06.03.2020 in which SEIAA noticed that along with other queries SEIAA has also asked - "The project has been submitted as a Multi feed of 100 KLPD (60 KLPD Molasses and 40 KLPD Grain) Distillery. Project proponent shall clarify, whether feeding of molasses and grain will be at the same time in the distillery to meet the required production of 100 KLPD per day or 60 KLD and 40 KLD distillation plant with the feed of molasses and grain respectively will be installed or some other mechanism is to proposed to be adopted. This should be clarified and changed accordingly in the EIA report and form-1 while submitting the signed copy." The project proponent has submitted his reply vide undated letter received in this office on 28.09.2020 and letter dated 29.01.2021. The letter dated 29.01.2021 mentions that EC is sought for 100 KLPD (60 KLPD molasses based and 40 KLPD grain based) while letter received on 28.09.2020 mentions that total production proposed is 100 KLPD (over written as 60 KLPD) signed by the same authority. Total production is not clear, hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall clarify the total production including the bifurcation for the both feeds proposed.

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Surendra Singh dated 26.12.2020 regarding the above subject. SEIAA opined that the letter shall be send to SEAC for review.



3. Sand/Morrum Mine of Gata No.-871 and 581Ga Near Village Pipardih and Koragi, Tehsil-Dudhi, District-Sonbhadra, U.P., (Leased Area:32.338 Ha). File No. 5031/4705/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/42156/2019

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Sandeep Singh Chandel, Secretary Abhinav Gramodyog Vikas Evam Seva Sansthan, Sonbhadra letter dated 25.11.2020 regarding illegal mining in the above area. SEIAA opined to refer the letter to DM, Sonbhadra and also to Geology & Mining Department for necessary action regarding the complaint.

4. Construction without Enviroment Clearance/NOC of project Located in Jankipuram Extention(Nehar road).

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Pawan Gupta dated 15.09.2020 regarding the above subject. SEIAA opined to refer the letter to UPPCB and also Regional Office, MoEF&CC, Lucknow for necessary action.

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Arvind Singh Rathore dated 22.10.2020 regarding the above cited subject. SEIAA opined that the letter shall be send to Director, DGM, and DM, kasganj for necessary action. SEIAA also opined to refer the letter to SEAC for report/comments/recommendation.

6. Expansion of Existing Tannery Unit from Capacity of 4.5 TPD of finished leather (wet blue to finished leather) to 5 TPD of Finished Leather (Raw To Finished Leather) at Plot No.-A-3/2 & A-3/3, Jainpur Industrial Area, Tehsil-Akbarpur, Kanpur Dehat, U.P., M/s Tirubala Exports (India) Pvt. Ltd. File No. 5713/Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND/ 54278/2020

SEIAA gone through the letter of the project proponent dated 18.12.2020 regarding a confirmation letter for standard ToR. SEIAA noted that the expansion case of this tannery has been taken in earlier SEIAA meeting and hence directed Nodal Officer SEIAA to put up the matter along with the old file.



1. Group Housing "Sport City" at Land Parcel SC-01/D3, Sector- 79, Noida, Shri I. M. Dubey, M/s Golf Green Estates Pvt. Ltd. File No. 6085/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/190402/2020

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

1. The project proponent shall submit the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project within the next 3 months.
2. The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.




3. The project proponent shall submit the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details within the next 3 months. The CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
4. The project proponent shall submit the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan within the next 3 months.
5. The project proponent shall submit the details of segregation plan of MSW within the next 3 months.
6. The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. To reuse the water for irrigation, sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained with the proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharged. Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be reused or discharged to the municipal sewer line.
7. The project proponent will ensure that a proper dust control management is practiced during the construction phase and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
8. The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to the water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
9. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.
10. In compliance to Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 13/01/2020 in IA no. 158128/2019 and 158129/2019 in Writ petition no. 13029/1985 (MC Mehta Vs GOI and others) anti-smog guns shall be installed to reduce dust during excavation.
11. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.





SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC that the project proponent shall submit point wise reply of MoEF&CC letter dated 21/12/2020.


