Jai Prakash Power Ventures Limited, Srikakulam, in Andhra Pradesh has requested for the Environmental Clearance to operate through semi-mechanized method for sand mining as the modified Mining Plan was approved as "The thickness of sand is above 3 meters in the Sand Reaches as reported by the Asst. Director of Mines & Geology. The reach shall be proposed to be operated through Semi-mechanized mode".

The Committee noted that MoEF&CC, GoI, New Delhi issued Notification vide S.O.No.141 dt:15.01.2016.

For sand mining the **District Survey Report** is to be prepared as per the prescribed procedure for sand mining or river bed mining and mining of other minor minerals is given in **Appendix- X of** as per the S.O.No.141 dt:15.01.2016.

The MoEF&CC, GoI, New Delhi issued guidelines in 2016 for sand mining "Sustainable Sand Mining Management Guidelines, 2016" and stated that for Identification and preparation of Mining Sites- (i) Mining should be done only in area / stretch identified in the District Level Survey Report suitable for mining and so certified by the Sub Divisional Level Committee after site visit. (ii)Mining should begin only after pucca pillar marking the boundary of lease area is erected at the cost of the lease holder after certification by the mining official and its geo coordinates are made available to the District Level Committee.
