

The SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. The SEIAA also added the following points to TOR,-

1. All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
2. Copy of all the analysis reports signed by analyst approved by NABL or MoEF&CC shall be annexed with the EIA report and original analysis reports should be presented at the time of presentation.
3. MOU signed between the project proponent and the consultant should be submitted.
4. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit along with EIA.
5. Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006(as amended).

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to issue Environmental Clearance with all the general and specific conditions. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that during monsoon season 262 KLD waste water is proposed to be recycled but for what purpose it will be used has not been mentioned. Also 20 KLD highly infectious hospital liquid waste is proposed to be reused. After treatment however, it is not clear where it will be reused. Details of treatment of liquid hospital waste along with its expected quality (including microbial quality) before and after treatment has not been submitted. The details of handling/treatment/disposal of ETP sludge has also not submitted. The complete details of treatment of biomedical waste/items required to be

treated/handled within premises and the detail for the proposed plan is to be provided. Hence SEIAA opined that project proponent shall submit the reply with the complete details of handling/treatment and disposal of the hospital liquid and solid waste on the points raised above.
