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Since, discharge of treated waste water/ storm water is a great concern and pose a serious problem for dwellers later, besides being a major pollution/ environmental issue," NOC/ clearance/ permission from appropriate authority are not submitted and instead, stated to be "under process/ will be submitted in due course of time/ will deposit cost with BDA" etc. are very subjective statements without definite time frame which later on may not get due attention and ultimately, inhabitants suffer environment gets polluted.

The proposed site is a low lying flood prone water logging area on the left side of NH while coming from Cutback to Bhuaneswar.
