C. CONSIDERATION OF (MODIFICATION OF EC) RECEIVED FROM SEIAA, ODISHA:

The SEAC recommended for modification of Environmental Clearance for change of name of two proposals as per **Annexure-C**. The SEAC recommended to return one proposal to SEIAA, Odisha with a request to ask the proponent to apply as B1 category since lease area is 5 ha return.

D. CONSIDERATION OF COUNTRY LIQUOR UNITS FOR EXTENSION OF VALIDITY OF EC (7 NOS.):

The SEAC reiterates its earlier recommendation for revalidation of country liquor proposals as decided in its meeting held on 31.10.2019 and opined that revalidation of Environmental Clearance for these 7 nos. of proposals as per **Annexure-D** are not required for the unit as these are already operational units. Further, the SEAC opined that fresh Environmental Clearance are also not required for the proposals as these are not shifting the unit to other location and / or going for higher production capacity. The SEAC recommended to return these proposals to SEIAA, Odisha with a request to communicate the proponents as above.
