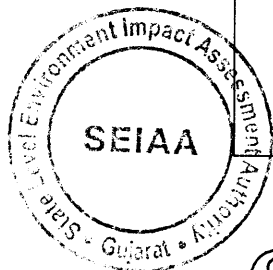


## Minutes of 1134<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 07<sup>th</sup> December 2023

The 1134<sup>th</sup> Meeting of State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) was held under the Chairmanship of Shri H. K. Dash and attended by Prof.(Dr.) V. K. Srivastava, Member (through online) and Shri Asav. P. Gadhi, Member Secretary of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) at Paryavaran Bhawan, Sector 10- A, Gandhinagar. **The following cases were taken up during the meeting:-**

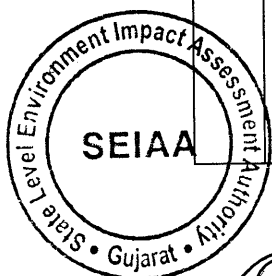
1.	<b>BVC Specialities Private Limited</b> , Plot No. D3/5/2, Vil. GIDC estate, Dahej – III, Ta. , Dist. Bharuch, Chemical Project - 5(f), Application Date: 22/04/2023, Proposal No:- 299565	EC amendment (Merger)	Deferred
<b>Deliberation &amp; Decision of SEIAA</b>			
The proposal of SEAC dated 04.12.2023 recommending the grant of Environment Clearance amendment cum merger was discussed.			
After detailed deliberation, the Environment Clearance is Deferred to SEAC for the verification of following points:			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Resolution of board of Directors of both industries, stating their No objection for merging of both units.</li> <li>2. PESO and fire permission, if taken, of existing units, have not been mentioned. For the same, if applied, dates shall be given</li> <li>3. TSDF validity expired on 06.01.2023. TSDF membership details of both units, which is not mentioned in SEAC Recommendation.</li> <li>4. CETP membership validity date after merger along with disposal quantity and spare quantity available by CETP may be given</li> <li>5. ETP plan as approved in the existing units will remain or there will be change has not been clarified. Site plan showing details of ETP after merger of both units (1000 KLD capacity), have to be examined with changes, if any and storage and conveyance of effluents, have to be explained.</li> <li>6. When, there is large storage of flammable, toxic chemicals, hydrogen gases etc, details of emergency measures after merger of units has not been in recommendation letter.</li> <li>7. Compliance of OM of MoEF &amp; CC dated 25.6.2014, has not been clarified.</li> <li>8. Looking to the large numbers of reactive chemicals used, if stream segregation requires.</li> </ol>

The proposal of SEAC dated 04.12.2023 recommending the approval of Terms of Reference was discussed.			
After detailed deliberation, TOR is approved incorporating all the conditions stipulated by SEAC and with conduct the public hearing, and PP shall submit all the details/data in revised format along with segregation of waste water stream, reduction/increase waste water if any applicable.			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Proponent shall carry out Public Hearing for their proposed project, as unit is located outside Notified industrial area.</li> <li>2. Proponent shall prepare Detail EIA report covering all points of public hearing proceedings.</li> <li>3. PP shall submit complete details of carbon footprints, water foot prints, carbon sequestration etc.</li> <li>4. PP shall incorporate details of schedule- I species in EC application</li> <li>5. Solvent utilization with quantity &amp; its management is to be included in EIA report.</li> </ol>



<p align="center"><b>Deliberation &amp; Decision of SEIAA</b></p> <p>The proposal of SEAC dated 04.12.2023 recommending the grant of EC was discussed. After detailed deliberation, the Environment Clearance is Referred Back to SEAC for the verification of following points:.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In SEAC recommendation in Table No 10 of format, only Part A of General condition is given, while part B is missing (for small units) and not given. SEAC is requested to submit details.</li> <li>Space availability for Gardening in premises for utilisation of treated effluent of 583 KLD, does not seem to be clear.</li> <li>Details of Fire permission &amp; PESO permission are not submitted/ mentioned in Recommendation.</li> <li>Water consumption for cooling water is 3268 KLD while wastewater generation in cooling is 153 KLD is not convincing &amp; not clear where detail of evaporation loss is 3115 KLD. detailed is to be submitted. Submit details with supportive documents.</li> <li>Further, 370 KLD water goes with product is not clear &amp; not convincing. Necessary details with supportive documents may be submitted, also included in SEAC recommendation.</li> <li>Environmental monitoring expenditure is in adequate.</li> <li>Approval for conservation plan for species of schedule-I, has not been mentioned.</li> <li>Stream segregation details have not been given.</li> </ol>

The proposal of SEAC dated 04.12.2023 recommending the grant of EC was discussed. SEAC noted that since, the unit falls in B1 category, and located in notified industrial area hence public consultation is not applicable as per paragraph 7 (i) III (i) (b) of the EIA notification, 2006.			
After detailed deliberation, the Environment Clearance is Referred Back to SEAC for the verification of following points:-			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Details of Solvent management are not included in SEAC recommendation, while proponent is using various solvents (column No 28).</li> <li>2. In SEAC recommendation in Table No 10 of format, only Part A of General condition is given, while part B is missing (for small units) and not given. SEAC is requested to submit details.</li> <li>3. Details of Fire permission &amp; PESO permission are not submitted in recommendation .</li> <li>4. PP shall submit approved conservation plan of schedule-I species.</li> </ol>

<b>Deliberation &amp; Decision of SEIAA</b>			
The proposal of SEAC dated 04.12.2023 recommending the grant of EC was discussed. Authority discussed that existing products are Non EC products, hence, CCR is not applicable in EC Expansion proposal.			
After detailed deliberation, the Environment Clearance is Granted incorporating all the conditions stipulated by SEAC, including the additional conditions prescribed in the minutes of 665th SEIAA meeting dated 06th December 2021 and given herein.			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Generated 3.5 KLD effluent generated from cooling and washing shall be treated in primary ETP followed by thermic fluid based forced evaporator and ZLD shall be maintained. There shall be no any ww discharge.</li> <li>2. Proponent shall obtain PESO and Fire permission from competent authority .</li> <li>3. PP shall submit provisional TSDF membership for ETP waste within 10 days time period.</li> <li>4. PP shall comply all conditions of public hearing proceedings and submit compliance in six month reports.</li> </ol>
