

**Minutes of the 134th meeting of Goa State Expert Appraisal Committee (Goa-SEAC)
held on the 14th July 2021 at 03.30 p.m. in the conference hall, 4th Floor, Dempo
Towers, Patto - Panaji, Goa.**

The 134th meeting of the Goa-SEAC was held on 14th July 2021 in the Conference room 4th floor of the Dempo Towers, Patto-Panaji at 3.30 p.m. under the Chairmanship of Shri. Gautam Desai. The list of members who attended the meeting is at "Annexure - 1".

The Chairman welcomed the members and requested Secretary, SEAC to proceed as per the agenda items (refer Annexure - 2).

1. Proposed project All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) located at Dhargal, Pernem - Goa dated 14th June 2021 on Parivesh.

The Committee inspected the site on 20th March 2021.

Committee has decided to recommend the ToR under General Conditions.

- i. An inventory of various features such as sensitive area, fragile areas, mining / industrial areas, habitation, water-bodies, major roads, etc. shall be prepared and furnished with EIA.
- ii. An inventory of flora & fauna based on actual ground survey shall be presented.
- iii. Risk factors with their management plan should be discussed in the EIA report.
- iv. The EIA report should be prepared by the accredited consultant having no conflict of interest.
- v. The EIA document shall be printed on both sides, as far as possible.
- vi. All documents should be properly indexed, page numbered.
- vii. Period/date of data collection should be clearly indicated.
- viii. The letter /application for EC should quote the SEIAA case No./year and also attach a copy of the letter prescribing the TOR.
- ix. The copy of the letter received from the SEAC prescribing TOR for the project should be attached as an annexure to the final EIA/EMP report.
- x. The final EIA/EMP report submitted to the SEIAA must incorporate all issues mentioned in TOR and that raised in Public Hearing with the generic structure as detailed out in the EIA report.
- xi. Grant of TOR does not mean grant of EC.
- xii. The status of accreditation of the EIA consultant with NABET/QCI shall be specifically mentioned. The consultant shall certify that his accreditation is for the sector for which this EIA is prepared.
- xiii. On the front page of EIA/EMP reports, the name of the consultant/consultancy firm along with their complete details including their accreditation, if any shall be indicated. The consultant while submitting the EIA/EMP report shall give an undertaking to the effect that the prescribed TORs (TOR proposed by the project proponent and additional TOR given by the MOEF & CC) have been complied with and the data submitted is factually correct.

- xiv. While submitting the EIA/EMP reports, the name of the experts associated with involved in the preparation of these reports and the laboratories through which the samples have been got analyzed should be stated in the report. It shall be indicated whether these laboratories are approved under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and also have NABL accreditation.
- xv. All the necessary NOC's duly verified by the competent authority should be annexed.
- xvi. PP has to submit the copy of earlier Consent condition /EC compliance report, whatever applicable along with EIA report.
- xvii. The EIA report should clearly mention activity wise EMP and CSR cost details and should depict clear breakup of the capital and recurring costs along with the timeline for incurring the capital cost. The basis of allocation of EMP and CSR cost should be detailed in the EIA report to enable the comparison of compliance with the commitment by the monitoring agencies.
- xviii. A time bound action plan should be provided in the EIA report for fulfillment of the EMP commitments mentioned in the EIA report.
- xix. The name and number of posts to be engaged by the PP for implementation and monitoring of environmental parameters should be specified in the EIA report.
- xx. EIA report should be strictly as per the TOR, comply with the generic structure as detailed out in the EIA notification, 2006, baseline data is accurate and concerns raised during the public hearing are adequately addressed.
- xxi. The EIA report should be prepared by the accredited consultant having no conflict of interest with any committee processing the case.

Validity –

- i. The TORs prescribed for the project will be valid for a period of three years for submission of EIA and EMP report.
- ii. This period of validity could be extended for a maximum period of one year provided an application is made by the applicant to the Regulatory Authority, at least three months before the expiry of valid period, together with an updated Form-I, based on proper justification and also recommendation of the EAC/SEAC.

2. Project proposal received from Dr. Prafulla R. Hede, Plot/Survey/Khasra No. 29/2, Village Collem, Tehsil-Dharbandora-Sanguem, South-Goa dated 19th March 2021 on Parivesh.

The Committee inspected the site on 09th June 2021.

The committee found that this is a case of violation. Hence, the proposal is not recommended for EC.

3. Project proposal received from Goa Cricket Association, for “Construction of Cricket Stadium” Dhargalim, Pernem - Goa dated 16th February 2021 on Parivesh.

The Committee inspected the site on 26th February 2021 and requested PP to clarify the following.

- i. The additional gate which is shown at the opening in the private property, the exit road may kindly be shown.

- ii. There is no proper developed road at the site and the PP is using the service road of WRD- Tillari Irrigation Canal. Hence, the access road may be proposed.
- iii. Extensive hill cutting will be required for construction of the project which will substantially damage the environment. PP may excavate hill cutting however with the approval of competent authority.
- iv. No endemic species were reported by PP as there exists a very rich ecosystem of specialized flora and fauna unique to the Goan Laterite Plateaus.
- v. The project proponent shall undertake fresh biodiversity survey for rainy season following all scientific protocols.

4. Proposed Project "Nirancal Basalt Quarry and Crusher" at Survey No. 58, Village Niranchal, Ponda Taluka, North Goa, by Shri. Akshay Uttam Khandeparkar dated 30th April 2021 on Parivesh.

The committee inspected the site on 09th June 2021.

- i. The project proponent shall undertake fresh biodiversity survey starting from October covering the winter season following all scientific protocols.
- ii. The project proponent shall measure the canopy density of the forest.
- iii. Identify any water source existing within the lease area. All activities related to agriculture especially kulaghars shall be mapped within the proximity of 5 sq. kms.

5. Proposed project Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited at Plot No. 150, Kundaim Industrial Estate, Ponda-Goa.

To decide on compliance submitted by Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited for expansion of LPG Mounded Storage Facility having capacity of 600MT (3x200MT) at plot no. 150, Kundaim Industrial Estate, Ponda-Goa.

The committee inspected the site on 30th June 2021 along with the staff of GSPCB.

The Committee noted that all the EC conditions are complied.

6. Proposed project of Parallel Taxi Track at Dabolim Airport issued by Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change.

The committee inspected the site on 30th June 2021 along with the staff of GSPCB.

The Committee noted that all the EC conditions are complied.

7. **Project M/s. Mahindra Holidays & Resorts India Limited bearing Survey No. 16/0 Part & 7/0 Part at Village Moitem, Bardez Taluka**

The committee inspected the site on 26th June 2021 along with the staff of GSPCB.

The Committee noted that all the EC conditions are complied.

8. **Proposed Project M/s. Prudential Developers Pvt. Ltd. in Chalta No. 34, P.T. Sheet No. 129, Margao, Gogol, Salcete Goa.**

The committee inspected the site on 26th June 2021.

It is observed that water logging in basement area and no hygienic condition on site are maintained.

It is also noted that no compliance report are submitted by the PP. This is a case of non compliance and to be reported as non compliance to SEIAA.
