1. Katri (Khand 14/11 to 14/12) Morrum Mine on Yamuna River located at Khand 14/11 to 14/12, Village- Katri, Teshil- Manjahanpur District- Kaushambi- 24.28 ha. Shri Kesri Nandan Singh, File No. 4152/Proposal No. (SIA/UP/ MIN/73677/2018)

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Sandeep Singh, Chitrakoot, received in the office on 16.06.2020 regarding category of the project. SEIAA decided to refer the letter to SEAC for comments.

2. Sand/Morrum Mining (Plot no.381, 378, 383, 382, 384, 385, 386 Mi, 391, (Khand-2)) Near Village: Korra Kanak, Fatehpur, Area- 40.48 ha. File No. 4691/4379/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/31813/2018

SEIAA gone through the letter of the project proponent dated 29.06.2020 along with Factual report of the above area prepared by M/S Academy of Science Communication. SEIAA gone through the file and documents and found that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 14.05.2020, wherein SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to send a letter to DM Fatehpur for providing the latest factual report of the site from competent authority. SEIAA also opined that reminder letter shall be sent to DGM and DM and the factual report of M/s Academy of Science Communication shall be forwarded to SEAC for comments.

SEIAA gone through the letter no. 1924/Khanan vibhag/2020 dated 10.06.2020 of DM Unnao addressed to DGM and endorsed to chairman, SEIAA regarding correction in pillar coordinates of the above projects. SEIAA opined that the above letter shall be referred to SEAC for comments.

6. River Bed Sand/Morrum Mining at Gata No.- 2556 and 2557, Khand no.-05Aa, Village-Bandhauri, Tehsil-Urai, Distt.-Jalaun,U.P., M/s A.S.V.P. Construction, Area 36.437 Ha. File No. 5664/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/53248/2020.

SEIAA gone through the letter dated 30.06.2020 of the project proponent regarding issuance of ToR. SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 19.06.2020 and opined that the project proponent shall submit clarification regarding the lease area in the DSR of Jalaun. The project proponent has submitted the reply dated 30.06.2020 along with the DSR amendment letter no- 1147/khanij-mmc-30 dated 01/06/2020 signed by Mining officer, Jalaun. After reviewing the reply SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC dated 08.06.2020 to grant additional ToR. SEIAA also added the following points to TOR:-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- Copy of all the analysis reports signed by analyst approved by NABL or MoEF&CC shall be annexed with the EIA report and original analysis reports should be presented at the time of presentation.
- 3- MOU signed between the project proponent and the consultant should be submitted.

- 4- The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit along with EIA.
- 5- The lease area its address and production per annum should match with as mentioned in DSR and Lol. In case there is any difference clarification/ amendment letter from competent authority shall be submitted along with EIA. EIA and public hearing shall be conducted as per the lease area its address and production per annum mentioned in DSR and Lol.
- 6- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).




Agenda-B:-Replies-

1. Rishita Mulberry Heights Group Housing at Pocket-6, Sector-C, Sushant Golf City, Hi-Tech Township, Lucknow., M/s Rishita Developers Pvt. Ltd. File No. 5381/4624/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/ 45971/2019

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 06.03.2020 in which SEIAA opined that the Project Proponent should submit the detail maps and permission of the competent authority to dispose-off surplus treated water in non-monsoon and monsoon season. The project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 05.06.2020. After reviewing the reply SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the









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general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 2- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
- 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
- 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
- 6- The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharged. Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be reused or discharged to any drain/nala/onland/inland surface water etc.
- 7- The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
- 8- The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
- 9- The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.
- 10- If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source.










2. Building Stone, Khanda, Gitti & Boulder Mining at Araj No.-626, Sr. No.-18, Village-Bhuili-III, Tehsil- Chaunar, District- Mirzapur, U.P., M/s Euphoria Mines and Minerals, (Leased Area -0.909 ha). File No. 4759/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 34475/2019

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 04-06-2020 in which SEIAA opined that the Project Proponent should submit the UPPCB letter dated 29-11-2019. The Project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 17-06-2020. After reviewing the reply SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC dated 19-05-2020 to grant EC to the above project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC adding three conditions:-

1. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
2. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.
3. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
4. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source.
5. Hon'ble NGT order in OA 1038/2018 dated 19-08-2019 by MoEF& CC, Govt. Of India vide letter dated 31-10-2019 shall be followed in letter and spirit.
6. All the additional condition for grant of Consent to Establish (CTE)/Consent to Operate (CTO) related to Pollution mitigation measures as prescribed in the office memorandum of MoEF&CC, Gol. dated 31.10.2019 and as deemed fit by UP Pollution Control Board in the consent orders shall be followed by Project Proponent.
