SEIAA gone through the recommendation of SEAC and noted that SEAC has recommended to issue EC to the above project. SEIAA also gone through file and documents and found that 70 KLD of total waste water will be generated for the treatment for which a STP of 200 KLD capacity has been proposed which seems to be of much excessive capacity. Justification/basis of STP capacity is not given. The surplus 24 KLD/37KLD treated waste water during non-monsoon/monsoon season has been proposed to be discharged in nearby drain which will ultimately find its way to Ganga Canal as per the map submitted: No consent/permission/MOU signed with irrigation department in this regard has been submitted by project proponent. Details regarding Biomedical Waste generation have also not been submitted. Hence, SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit the clarification on the above points along with the relevant supporting documents.

8. Government Medical College at Khasra No.-1206 & 1093, Village- Siraon, District-Etah, Principal, Government Medical College, Etah, U.P. File No. 5612/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/149174/2020

SEIAA gone through the recommendation of SEAC and noted that SEAC has recommended to issue EC to the above project. SEIAA also gone through file and documents and found that 189 KLD of total waste water will be generated for the treatment for which a STP of 500 KLD capacity has been proposed, which is of very excessive capacity. Similarly, 8 KLD of waste water will be generated from the laboratories for which an ETP of 25 KLD has been proposed. Justification/basis of such a high ETP and STP capacity is not given. The surplus 76 KLD/92 KLD treated waste water during non-monsoon/monsoon season has been proposed to be discharged in nearby runoff drain which will ultimately find its way to Lower Ganga Canal as per the map submitted by project proponent. No consent/permission/MOU signed with irrigation department for the discharge of its waste water in Lower Ganga Canal has been submitted by project proponent. Details for generation and disposal of Biomedical Waste have also not been submitted. Hence, SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit the clarification/information on the above points along with the relevant supporting documents.

9. Development of Rose County East, Village-Sandauli Umarpur, Pargana- Devi Nawabganj, District-Barabanki, U.P. M/s ARG Infrastructures Pvt. Ltd. File No. 5628/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/149811/2020

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to defer the matter as per request made by project proponent and to discuss the matter only after submission of online request on prescribed portal.

10. Group Housing at Plot No.-SC-01/C-AS, Sector- 150, Greater Noida, District-Gautam Buddha Nagar, U.P. , M/s Augur Realtors Pvt. Ltd. File No. 5636/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/150198/2020


SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC that the matter shall be discussed after submission of information on prescribed online portal.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to close the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal.

The SEIAA gone through the minutes and noted the project applied on for amendment in EC vide letter dated 23/01/2020. SEIAA also noted that earlier EC was issued to project proponent vide letter dated 02.06.2011 and extension of validity vide letter dated

28.08.2018 having a validity till 30.05.2020. Project proponent has applied for amendment on dated 23.01.2020 which is within the validity period of the EC i.e. 30.05.2020. K14011/12/2020-amrut-IIA dated 28.05.2020 of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs regarding advisory for extensions of validity and time limit of all approvals, NOCs and subsequent compliances given by State and Central agencies for real estate sector.
