The SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. The SEIAA also added the following points to TOR;-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- Copy of all the analysis reports signed by analyst approved by NABL or MoEF&CC shall be annexed with the EIA report and original analysis reports should be presented at the time of presentation.
- 3- MOU signed between the project proponent and the consultant should be submitted.
- 4- The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit along with EIA.
- 5- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).
- 6- Proposal using state of art/ latest technology for the treatment of waste water to achieve ZLD shall be submitted in EIA.

The SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that only form-1 is available in the file. SEIAA Secretariat informed that project proponent has been asked to submit the presentations/all relevant details in hard copy by 04.06.2020 but it has not been submitted yet. In the SEAC minutes it is mentioned that Environmental clearance for the earlier proposal was issued by SEIAA, U.P. vide letter no. 3318/SEAC/1097/2011/DDY dated 21/03/2013. It is not clear whether the present project proposal is for amendment, revision, expansion or new Certified Compliance Report of MoEF&CC for the previous EC is also not available in file. SEIAA directed the Nodal Officer to put up the complete file along with all the documents as and when made available by project proponent and place it to the next meeting.

The SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to Issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that only form-1 is available in the file. Secretariat informed that project proponent has been asked to submit the presentations/all relevant details in hard copy by 04.06.2020 but it has not been submitted yet. In the SEAC minutes it is mentioned that Environmental clearance for the earlier proposal was issued by SEIAA, U.P. vide letter no. 3318/SEAC/1097/2011/DDY dated 21/03/2013. It is not clear whether the present project proposal is for amendment, revision, expansion or new Certified Compliance Report of MoEF&CC for the previous EC is also not available in file. SEIAA directed the Nodal Officer to put up the complete file along with all the documents as and when made available by project proponent and place it to the next meeting.

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to issue ToR to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that application is made for gata no. 392/1 area-17.71 ha whereas in DSR, gata no. 392/1, 393, 396, area-71.356 hac is mentioned. SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. The SEIAA also added the following points to TOR;-

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- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- Copy of all the analysis reports signed by analyst approved by NABL or MoEF&CC shall be annexed with the EIA report and original analysis reports should be presented at the time of presentation.
- 3- MOU signed between the project proponent and the consultant should be submitted.
- 4- The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit along with EIA.

SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that application is made for 22 hac whereas in DSR for Khand no.- 22/4, area is mentioned as 36.437 hac. SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. The SEIAA also added the following points to TOR;-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- Copy of all the analysis reports signed by analyst approved by NABL or MoEF&CC shall be annexed with the EIA report and original analysis reports should be presented at the time of presentation.
- 3- MOU signed between the project proponent and the consultant should be submitted.
- 4- The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit along with EIA.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC that the case will be taken when the complete documents is submitted to the Secretariat.

 Building Stone, (Khandas & Gitti, Boulder) Mine at Gata No./Araji No./Plot No.- 281, Khand No.- 01, Villlage-Marodakhurd, Tehsil- Moth, District- Jhansi, U.P., M/s Harihar Stone Gramodhyog, Leased Area -0.890 ha. File No. 4734/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 33155/2018

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC adding three conditions:-

- 1. If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate.
- The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.
- The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake regrassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.

area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions
based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and
joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to defer the matter on request of project proponent for next SEAC meeting. The matter will be discussed only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal.

12. Building Stone (Khandas, Gitti & Boulder) Mining at Gata No.- 967, Khand No.- 03, at Village- Karbai, , District- Mahoba U.P., Area -2.024 ha. File No. 5152/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 45344/2019

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to defer the matter on request of project proponent for next SEAC meeting. The matter will be discussed only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal.

13. River Bed Sand/Morrum Mining at Gata No.- 2556 and 2557, Khand no.-05Aa, Village-Bandhauli, Tehsil-Urai, Distt.-Jalaun, U.P., M/s A.S.V.P. Construction, Area 36.437 Ha. File No. 5664/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/53248/2020

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to issue ToR. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that gata no. 2556 and 2557 are not present in DSR. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent should submit clarification in this regard.

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# Modification of Shipra Commercial Complex at Plot No.- 10/3, Vaibhav Khand, Indrapuram, District- Ghaziabad, U.P., M/s Shipra Estate Ltd. File No. 5680/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/155459/2020

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

- 1- Since the proposed project falls in Critically Polluted Areas (CPAs), Severely Polluted Areas (SPAs) the provision of the mechanism farmed regarding compliance of Hon'ble NGT order in OA 1038/2018 dated 19-08-2019 by MoEF& CC, Govt. Of India vide letter dated 31-10-2019 shall be followed in letter and spirit.
- 2- All the additional condition for grant of Consent to Establish (CTE)/Consent to Operate (CTO) related to Pollution mitigation measures as prescribed in the office memorandum of MoEF&CC, Gol. dated 31.10.2019 and as deemed fit by UP Pollution Control Board in the consent orders shall be followed by Project Proponent.
- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 4- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
- 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
- 6- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
- 7- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
- 8- The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and ZLD is achieved as proposed.
- 9- The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
- 10-The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
- 11- The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.

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- 12- In compliance to Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 13/01/2020 in IA no. 158128/2019 and 158129/2019 in Writ petition no. 13029/1985 (MC Mehta Vs GOI and others) anti smog guns shall be installed to reduce dust during excavation.
- 13-If the proposed project is signtated in notified area of ground water extraction where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source.
- Bhawani Bux Ordinary Sand Mining in Yamuna River at Gata No.-2 Mi, , in Village-Mandanpur, Tehsil- Etmadpur, District-Agra, U.P., (Leased Area: 7.28 Ha) File No. 4264/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 74773/2018

SEIAA noted that this project was taken in its meeting dated 01.06.2018 and 23.06.2018 wherein matter was referred back to SEAC due to difference in the minable reserve in various documents submitted by project proponent and availability of water level at 1 mt, depth, as informed by project proponent, and hence SEAC was asked to constitute a subcommittee of 2-3 members of SEAC, concerned RO, UPPCB and DMO for the site inspection. SEIAA found that SEAC stating that site inspection has not been undertaken by yet and cannot done in the present time due to Covid-19, has forwarded the earlier recommendation to grant the Environment Clearance along with general and specific conditions stipulated by the SEAC in its 339<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dated 18/05/2018. SEIAA also noted that area of lease is 7.28 hac and no mentions has been made by SEAC regarding category of the project (B1, B2) and hence, referred back the project to SEAC for review/comments.
