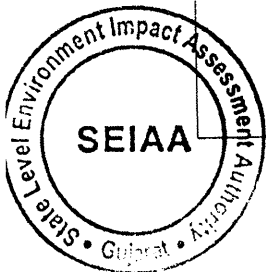


Minutes of the 928 (Part I) Meeting held on 11th November 2022

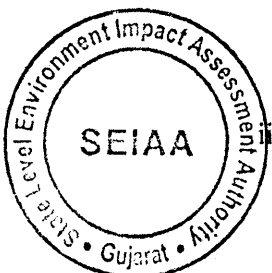


Note:

- The email-letter received dated 09.11.2022 was discussed in SEIAA. As advised by SEAC no new application should be sent by SEIAA to SEAC. In case of new application Member Secretary, SEIAA may decide to return the applications in case of sand mining with a remark that proponent may resubmit after completion of the District Survey Report process or any direction from the Apex Court as may be available.
- Regarding the judgement of NGT on sand mining, the letter written to Commissioner of Geology and Mining as to process of completion of District Survey Report is yet to be received. Meanwhile, a letter written to District Geologist is seen by SEIAA. It may be sent to SEAC for confirmation after taking any legal opinion, if required.
- In view of the direction of the High Court in case no. SCA no. 6329/2022, 6504/2022, 6362/2022, 6365/2022, 6366/2022 others. dated 10.10.2022, it appears

the proponent has to give an undertaking to the Collector not to start any operation without EC, meanwhile SEIAA should expedite grant of EC if the applications have been received. In view of this, SEAC may do necessary appraisal of such cases including refer back cases if any in mining except sand mining for which it has been discussed above.
