- 2. The D.G. Set location at tower -3 should be relocated not less than 30 m from the boundary.
- STP should be relocated away for the boundary of site in order to avoid nuisances to the already developed residential area.
- STP shall be open type or in case closed type no other activity such as car parking etc shall be earmarked.
- 5. The project proponent has to provide rain water harvesting collection tank to the capacity of 1100 cu.m in order to recover and reuse the rain water during normal rains.
- 6. There should be Fire fighting plan and all required safety plan.

Discussed in detail, the Authority decided to call for the following additional details:

- The land use breakup is not matching with the actual requirement and it appears that present land is not sufficient to meet the land requirement of the proposed expansion.
- 2. MOU signed between the cement manufacture and the project proponent for the disposal of furnace slag.
- 3. There are agricultural lands close to the plant site. Whether baseline study carried out including any station in such areas. If so, furnish the report.
- 4. The AAQ survey conducted on 06.01.2017 shows some of the parameter exceeds the annual standards. Hence, request to justify the same. The project proponent should justify the performance of the existing Air pollution control measures.

Discussed in detail, the Authority decided to recommend the project for the to grant Environment Clearance subject to the following condition:

- 1. The Project Proponent has to conduct Ambient Air Quality survey twice in a week (104 times) in a year and monitor the PM 10 & PM 2.5.
- 2. A systematic site/ ecological rehabilitation and restoration plan on long term basis should be drawn to carryout restoration with native species and Bio diversity.
