- 1. Environment Clearances is subject to the outcome of the Hon'ble High Court in the W.P.(C) 12517/2018 & CM APPL. 48579/2018 and W.P.(C) 12570/2018 & CM Appl. 48897/2018.
- 2. The proponent should strictly comply with, Tamil Nadu Government Order (Ms) No.84 Environment and forests (EC.2) Department dated 25.06.2018 regarding ban on one time use and throwaway plastics irrespective of thickness with effect from 01.01.2019 under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 3. The proponent shall develop the green belt as per the plan furnished and area earmarked for the greenbelt shall not be alter at any point of time for any other purpose.
- 4. At any cost, treated/untreated sewage should not be discharged into the nearby water bodies. Similarly, the nearby water bodies should not be polluted

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- with municipal solid waste generated from the project.
- 5. Household hazardous waste such as batteries, small electronics, CFL bulbs, expired medicines and used cleaning solvent bottles should be segregated at source, collected once in a month from residences and disposed as per the SWM rules 2016.
- 6. The proponent should strictly implemented and follow the commitment made in the project proposal.
- 7. The Project Proponent has to provide rain water harvesting collection tank to the capacity of 500cu.m of 31 numbers of pits with dimensions dia 1.0m depth 1.3m as committed.

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
