The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (<100 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease). The representative of proponent and their consultant AMPLENVIRON PRIVATE LIMITED have attended the meeting. The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC' Notifications & OMs, detailed deliberations, recommended to issue Environmental Clearance for Quartz, Silica Sand, Dolomite & Lime Kankar -138030 TPA. 1. No blasting and not to operate after 6.00 PM as per forest NOC conditions 2. 500 m trench and Bunds on Western and Southern, North side to prevent surface runoff.
