1. The SEAC in its meeting held on 17.11.2020 decided that the appraisal for issue of ToRs for the minor mineral proposals of lease area 25 ha. or less (including cluster approach) may be considered with specific ToRs as suggested by SEAC as well as standard ToRs based on merit of the proposal without presentation.
2. The SEIAA, Odisha has forwarded 23 online EC applications of minor mineral proposals of lease area 25 ha. or less (including cluster approach) as per **Annexure-C**.

After detailed discussion, the SEAC decided to forward such 23 online EC applications to SEIAA, Odisha with a request to issue specific ToRs as suggested by SEAC as well as standard ToRs to these 23 proposals for conducting EIA study.




