C. CONSIDERATION OF MINOR MINERAL PROPOSALS (MODIFICATION OF EC - 26 NOS.):

The SEAC has received 26 minor mineral proposals for Modification of Environmental Clearance as per **Annexure-C**. The SEIAA has already appraised these proposals in its 83rd, 84th and 85th Meeting. The SEAC recommended to return these proposals to SEIAA, Odisha as decision has already been taken by the SEIAA.

D. CONSIDERATION OF MINOR MINERAL PROPOSAL FOR SITE VISIT

1. The SEIAA, Odisha has forwarded following minor mineral proposal for Modification of Environmental Clearance with a request that SEAC may do detail appraisal by careful inspection of the site and the operations carried out there. 45000 cum of sand extraction is an unsustainably high rate of exploitation:
 - a) Tulasipur Sand Quarry over an area of 4.856 Ha under Marshaghai Tahasil of Kendrapara District Odisha.
2. The PP had obtained EC vide letter no. 1112/SEIAA dated 30.03.2021 with maximum annual production of sand 45110 cum with depth 1.7 meter.
3. Now, proposal for same production capacity from 45110 cum/annum on the basis of replenishment study report.
4. As per the mining plan Geological reserve-84762 Cum, Mineral reserve - 46012 Cum.
5. As per pre-monsoon and post monsoon data of replenishment study, the Geological reserve-74590 Cum and Mineable reserve-39110 Cum.

After detailed discussion, the SEAC decided to take decision on the proposal after conducting a field visit once monsoon is over.
