The UTEAC (Union Territory Expert Appraisal Committee), DNH& DD, during the meeting held on 11th August, 2021, appraised the "Proposed construction project 'SWAGAT' by M/s. Silvassa Reality" and has recommended the proposal to UTEIAA for grant of Environmental Clearance. The Project Proponents have applied with UTEIAA stating that the project falls under the 8 (a) Category as per the EPA Notification. 2006.

After detailed discussion on the project proposal and considering the following observations/directions made by UTEAC, i.e;

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- The project proponent should maintain minimum 30% of the entire project area as Green Belt. The green belt should be raised with local and native species.
- The project proponent must keep Rs 50 Lakhs for Corporate Environment Responsibility and Rs 50 Lakhs for Corporate Social Responsibility for the proposed project and entire money should be spent within two years of initiating the construction activities.
- No trees will be cut by project without permission from authorities. The project
 proponent must submit a letter from the concerned Deputy Conservator of
 Forest regarding permission for the access road connecting the project site to
 the nearby main road.
- 4. Monitoring of environmental parameters will be carried out as per rules and guidelines issued under Environment (Protection) Act 1986,

and based on the undertaking provided with respect to compliance of the CSR & CER condition stipulated, the UTEIAA has unanimously agreed to grant of Environmental Clearance with the conditions as recommended by UTEAC along with the General and Specific conditions as stipulated for projects of this category and nature.

The UTEIAA also stipulated that the as far as CER and CSR allocations are concerned, the project proponents are to prominently display the details of budget allocation and the expenditure thereof, to the public, under these heads for a better transparency. Further the UTEIAA also stipulated that Green Belt/Green Area be 33 % of the project area and to ensure sustainable maintenance of the Green Belt/Area and for better nutritional security of the community through nutri-gardens a suitable plant nursery is also to be established within the premises. - The project proponent should carry out all activities as proposed under the Corporate Environmental Responsibility Plans in the first and second year of the project instead of five years as proposed by them.
- The Project proponent must submit the vetted copy of the Project cost by PWD, DNH & DD to SEIAA.
- The project proponent should implement the green belt and plantation scheme by planting only local species, mostly Evergreen species or as suggested by the concerned DFO.
- Monitoring of environmental parameters will be carried out as per rules and guidelines issued under E(P) Act 1986.

The UTEAC (Union Territory Expert Appraisal Committee), DNH& DD, during the meeting held on 11th August, 2021, had appraised the project, "M/s. Shri Devshibhai L. Bhatu" and recommended the project to UTEIAA for consideration of grant of Environmental Clearance.

The project falls under the 8 (a) Category as per the EPA Notification, 2006. After detailed discussion on the project proposal and considering the following observations/directions made by UTEAC, i.e;

- The project proponent should maintain minimum 30 % as Green belt area with locally available species. It must be noted that the Green belt area doesn't include Lawns, play grounds, tennis courts, etc.
- The project proponent must maintain at least 2 rows of plantation (only perennial species selected after consultation with local DCF) within the project boundary.
- Necessary permission for Road access from the project may be obtained from forest department as applicable.
- Implementation plan of CER and CSR may be submitted to SEIAA with maximum of completion schedule of two years to benefit the environment and communities of the area.
- 5. Rainwater recharge and harvesting plan for 19042m3/yr. collected water as proposed may be implemented. During rainy season, harvested water may be utilized for irrigation of green belt lawns and gardens reducing the drawl of ground water. The agency to make Water tanker supply to project must also have CGWA approval as per guidelines applicable.
- 6. Monitoring of environmental parameters will be carried out as per rules and guidelines issued under E(P) Act 1986.

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and based on the undertaking provided with respect to compliance of the CSR & CER condition and water tanker supply to project to have CGWA approval as per guidelines applicable, as stipulated by the UTEAC, the UTEIAA has unanimously agreed to grant of Environmental Clearance with the conditions as recommended by UTEAC along with the General and Specific conditions as stipulated for projects of this category and nature.

The UTEIAA also stipulated that the as far as CER and CSR allocations are concerned, the project proponents are to prominently display the details of budget allocation and the expenditure thereof, to the public, under these heads for a better transparency. Further the UTEIAA also stipulated that Green Belt/Green Area be 33 % of the project area and to ensure sustainable maintenance of the Green Belt/Area and for better nutritional security of the community through nutri-gardens a suitable plant nursery is also to be established within the premises.
