The meeting of 645th State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) was held on-line on 01.09.2022 at the Directorate of Environment. The following were present in the meeting:-

1. Expansion of Group Housing "Sharanam" at Plot No. GH-02, Sector-107, Noida, U.P., Shri Rama Sankar, M/s Great Value Project India Ltd. File No. 7181/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/78947/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC-1 to issue additional ToR to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies under the provisions of MoEFCC, GoI vide OM no. 22-21/2020-IA.III dated 07.07.2021 which has laid down Standard Operating Procedure (SoP) for Identification and handling of violation cases. SEIAA opined as follows –

- PP / consultant to submit compliance report through IRO, MoEFCC, GoI, Lucknow of existing EC granted to the project
- PP / consultant to submit compliance report of earlier CtE and CtO through UPSPCB.
- PP / consultant to submit point-wise compliance, in a tabular form, of MoEFCC, GoI OM no. 22-21/2020-IA.III dated 07.07.2021 (SoP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification 2006)
- Further, SEIAA added that without prejudice to any other consequences, action to be initiated u/s 15 read with section-19 of EPA, 1986 against the PP and Project to be closed until EC is granted.
- SEIAA opined that recommendation made by SEAC-1 and documents submitted by PP / consultant will be examined (at the time of EIA appraisal) only after above conditions imposed by SEIAA are complied with.
- A letter shall be send to DM, Gautam Budh Nagar; CEO, Noida Development Authority; and MS, SPCB to ensure that no construction is started until valid EC is obtained and in case construction has been carried out without valid EC then work should be stopped and legal action should be initiated against the PP



2. Expansion of Existing unit from 70mt/day to 280mt/day having production of 89,600 MTA Billets through Electrical/ Induction Furnace at Khasra No. 140, 141, 144/240, 144/241, 144me, 189 Village – Dumduma, Tehsil Chunar, District – Mirzapur, M/s Maa Mahamaya Alloys Private Limited. File No. 7182/Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND/79159/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC-1 to issue standard terms of reference prescribed by MoEFCC along with additional ToR for the preparation of EIA adding the following conditions:-

1. The Project proponent shall submit certified compliance report of earlier EC along with EIA.
2. The Project proponent shall submit compliance of CtE/CtO.

3. Township Project "Gaur Yamuna City" at sector-19, Yamuna Expressway, YEIDA, Greater Noida, U.P., M/s Gaursons Realtech Pvt. Ltd. Shri Devenra Bhandari. File No. 1657/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/280537/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC-1 to amend the environmental clearance letter no. 2093/PARYA/SEAC/1657/2013/JDCA(S)/PART-1 dated 12/10/2013 as recommended SEAC-1. Rest all the contents mentioned in Environmental Clearance letter dated 12/10/2013 shall remain the same. SEIAA also noted that environmental clearance is valid upto 11/10/2023.

4. Sand Mining at Yamuna River Bed, Khand No.06,Vill.Maghiyari Bhambhor, Tehsil-Bara, District-Prayagraj, U.P., Shri Chandrajeet Kushwaha, M/s Tara Enterprises, Area: 10.0 ha. File No. 7169/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/77353/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC-1 to issue additional ToR to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. SEIAA added following points to ToR-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- The lease area its address and production per annum should match with as mentioned in DSR and Lol. In case there is any difference clarification/ amendment letter from competent authority shall be submitted along with EIA. EIA and public hearing shall be conducted as per the lease area its address and production per annum mentioned in DSR and Lol.
- 3- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).
- 4- SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit permission of CGWA or proposal for alternative source of fresh water.
- 5- KML file for the area and mining lease area should be provided.
- 6- Status of leases granted/to be granted in various mining khands along with production since the formulation of DSR, duly certified by the competent authority should be submitted.
- 7- In case project proponent intends to temporarily store mined out material or any tools, equipment's or other material outside mine lease area then NOC from competent authority for doing so should be submitted and details of such area and associated Environmental impacts should be included in EIA-EMP report. This should also be clearly mentioned during public hearing.
- 8- Road network to be used by the project should be clearly shown on Survey of India toposheet in 1:50,000 scale. In case road network involves forest road, permission should be obtained from Forest Department and a copy of the same should be submitted at the time of appraisal of EIA-EMP report.



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- 9- The project proponent should clearly spell out whether it is a green field or brown field project. In case it is a brown field project and -
 - (i) If the earlier and present lease holder are same then compliance report of previous EC should be submitted.
 - (ii) If the earlier and present lease holder are different then environmental footprint of the site and mitigation measures should be included in EIA-EMP report.
 - 10- In case of expansion / renewal of earlier EC, following information should be submitted
 - a. Status of compliance of earlier EC conditions by Integrated Regional Office, MoEFCC, GoI, Lucknow.
 - b. Copy of CTE and CTO issued by SPCB.
 - c. Status of submission of six-monthly compliance report to EC granted earlier
 - d. Court cases, if any.
 - 11- Observations raised in public hearing, replies submitted by project proponent, suitable modifications carried out in EIA-EMP report.
 - 12 PP / consultant in compliance to Hon'ble NGT order dated 06.05.2022 in OA no. 141/2021 (With report dated 31.03.2022) Raj Kumar Vs. State of UP and Others and with OA no. 141/2021 Rajkaran Karn Vs. State of UP and Others, will submit replenishment study, duly approved by DGM, along with EIA-EMP report for seeking EC.
 - 13- Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 10,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants below Uttar Pradesh Forest Department's survival rate will be treated as violation of EC condition.
 - 14- In consultation with District Environment Authority or an Authority nominated by concerned DM, project proponent will prepared a conservation and management plan for rejuvenation and management of water bodies having total surface area of more than 540 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six monthly compliance status will be presented by project proponent before the nominated authority in the District.
 - 15- Along with the EIA-EMP report, PP / consultant will also submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed entire ToR while preparing draft EIA-EMP report for PH. Further, PP / consultant will submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed issues raised during public hearing and have incorporated the same in final EIA-EMP report. A presentation to this effect should be made before SEAC at the time of EIA-EMP presentation.
5. **Stone (Khanda, Boulder, Bailast (Gitti) Mining at Arazi No.-464 (Khand-01), Vill.- Pahara, Tehsil-Garautha, Jhansi, Shri Deeraj Kumar Prajapati, Area 1.618 ha. File No. 7170/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/281081/2022**

In light of discussion held in SEIAA meeting no. 597 dated 05.05.2022. SEIAA opined to accept the recommendations of SEAC-1 to grant prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by SEAC-1 but SEIAA replaces the specific condition regarding cluster certificate as "If in future



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during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate" and adding following conditions:-

1. Validity period of this EC is 5 years from the date of issue as the Lol has been issued for a period of 5 years or co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier. After this period the EC will become null and void.
2. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
3. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
4. Three tier green shelter belt of 7.5m width should be developed on the periphery of mine lease area. Local and native species should be planted in consultation with Forest/Horticulture Department/Agriculture University.
5. Plan for using the mine void for productive use in consultation with local administration and gram-panchayat.
6. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
7. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 2,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.
8. In consultation with District Environment Authority or an Authority nominated by concerned DM, project proponent will prepared a conservation and management plan for rejuvenation and management of water bodies having total surface area of more than 10 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six monthly compliance status will be presented by project proponent before the nominated authority in the District.
9. Department of Geology and Mines, Government of Uttar Pradesh and / or concerned district administration, before releasing the security deposit to Project Proponent will ensure that Project Proponent has fully complied with the EC conditions. Non-compliance, if any, should be reported to UPSPCB for appropriate legal action and recovery of compensation.
10. Any application for transfer of this EC, during its validity period unless it is cancelled by a competent authority, has to be necessarily accompanied with status of compliance of EC conditions duly certified by IRO, MoEFCC, GoI, Lucknow.



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11. If the air quality deteriorates due to mining, then District Administration & Directorate of Mining should ensure that mining be stopped immediately. Adequate measures be taken for restoring air quality and mining should commence only when air quality attains the prescribed standards.

6. Expansion of Institutional Building "Eye of Noida (EON)" at Plot No.01A, Sector-140A, Noida., Shri Rajiv Kumar, M/s Fairfax IT Infra Pvt. Ltd. File No. 7172/6986/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/79155/2022

SEIAA took note of comments recorded by SEAC-1

7. Khanda Boulder (Dolo Stone) Mining at Arazi No. 5480Mi, 5423, 5479, 5478, Village-Billi Markundi, Tehsil-Obra, Sonbhadra, Smt Rinki Srivastava, Area - 1.935 ha. File No. 7018/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/74781/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC-1 to issue additional ToR to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. SEIAA added following points to ToR-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- The lease area its address and production per annum should match with as mentioned in DSR and Lol. In case there is any difference clarification/ amendment letter from competent authority shall be submitted along with EIA. EIA and public hearing shall be conducted as per the lease area its address and production per annum mentioned in DSR and Lol.
- 3- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).
- 4- Plan for using the mine void for productive use in consultation with local administration and gram-panchayat.
- 5- SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit permission of CGWA or proposal for alternative source of fresh water.
- 6- KML file for the area and mining lease area should be provided.
- 7- Status of leases granted/to be granted in various mining khands along with production since the formulation of DSR, duly certified by the competent authority should be submitted.

In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 2,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants below Uttar Pradesh Forest Department's survival rate will be treated as violation of EC condition.
- 14- Project Proponent / Consultant has given an affidavit that the project area doesn't fall within the boundary of Critically Polluted Area (CPA). If the affidavit given by PP / Consultant is found to be false then ToR / EC will be cancelled and legal actions will be initiated against them. Further, certificate from concerned RO, UPSPCB that area doesn't attract CPA and a copy of the same should be submitted at the time of evaluation of EIA-EMP report by SEAC.
- 15- In consultation with District Environment Authority or an authority nominated by concerned DM, Project Proponent will prepare a conservation and management plan for the rejuvenation and management of water bodies having a total surface area of not less than 10 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six-monthly implementation status will be presented by the Project Proponent before the nominated authority in the district.
- 16- Number of mining projects are coming up in district. Department of Geology & Mines, GoUP to carry out regional EIA-EMP report including carrying capacity of environmental components to assess the capacity to further bear the pollution load for such areas within a period of 1 year and submit the same to SEIAA, UP for evaluation.
- 17- Department of Geology & Mines, GoUP in consultation with UPSPCB will establish required number of CAAQMS in district within a period of one year and submit geo-referenced map of these stations along with data. Details of existing CAAQMS, if any, be submitted within a period of three months.
- 18- Along with the EIA-EMP report, PP / consultant will also submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed entire ToR while preparing draft EIA-EMP report for PH. Further, PP / consultant will submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed issues raised during public hearing and have incorporated the same in final EIA-EMP report. A presentation to this effect should be made before SEAC at the time of EIA-EMP presentation.
- 19- Project Proponent in consultation with UPSPCB will establish required number of CAAQMS within a period of one year and submit geo-referenced map of these stations along with data on six-monthly basis.

SEIAA noted that SEAC-1 has recommended to issue standard ToR to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that the project proponent has not submitted readable Khasra Map and the KML shows that mining area also includes area falling in the State of Haryana. Hence SEIAA opined that the project shall be referred back to SEAC-1 for deliberation/comments.

9. Building Stone (Sand Stone) Mining Project at Araj No - 399, Village: Jigna, Tehsil-Chunar, Mirzapur, Shri Om Prakash Singh. Area- 0.606 Ha. File No. 6722/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/69695/2021

SEIAA noted that SEAC-1 has recommended to issue standard ToR to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that the project proponent shall submit documents related to DSR issued either by the competent authority or issued under approval from competent authority

10. Stone (Boulder, Khanda / Gitti-Ballast) at Gata No. 115 (Khand No.- 02), Village-Habupura, Tehsil- Garautha & District- Jhansi, Smt. Rachna Khatri., Area- 3.238 Ha. File No. 6808/6024/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/70159/2020

SEIAA took note of comments recorded by SEAC-1.

11. Sand Mining at Gata No.-99 mi,101 mi, 102 mi & 103, Khanda No.- 02, Village-Bijhalpur, Tehsil-Ajitmal,District-Auraiya.Shri Dheeraj Panday.,Area-11.9595 Ha. File No. 6766/5849/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/70187/2020

In light of discussion held in SEIAA meeting no. 597 dated 05.05.2022. SEIAA opined to accept the recommendation of SEAC-1 and grant EC to the said project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by SEAC 1 adding following specific conditions:-

1. Validity period of this EC is 5 years from the date of issue as the Lol has been issued for a period of 5 years or co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier. After this period the EC will become null and void.
2. In the absence of replenishment study, in compliance of Hon'ble NGT Order dated 06.05.2022 initially the EC will be operational till 31.12.2022. Permissible quantity and area shall be strictly limited to quantity and area mentioned in Lol or mining plan, whichever is lesser, and maximum mineable depth will be limited to as approved in the mining plan.
3. For subsequent years, Project Proponent shall submit fresh annual replenishment study to SEIAA, UP for amendment in EC for mineable quantity and maximum permissible depth for mining based on scientific findings of replenishment study. Such study shall be placed before SEAC for appraisal for next three years to assess rate of deposition and accordingly, mineable production capacity and depth can be prescribed based on trends analysis, provided it is found scientifically satisfactory by the SEAC. The placing of the study report SEAC is mandatory for initial three years.
4. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.

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5. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
 6. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
 7. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.

This project was discussed in SEIAA meeting no. 630 dated 13.07.2022 where SEIAA opined as follows –

“SEIAA noted that SEAC-1 has recommended to issue Terms of reference to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that in MoM, proposed production /year of Silica sand is mentioned as 46,843 m³ and of stone is mentioned as 31,229 m³ whereas in LOI and mining plan approval letter proposed production /year of Silica sand is mentioned as 46,843 m³ only and there is no details regarding stone production. Hence SEIAA opined that showcase notice be



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issued to consultant along with copy to QCI & NABET and bring it to the notice of DGM. Proposal be referred back to SEAC-1 for re-evaluation."

SEAC-1 has recommended as follows –

"In view of above, the committee opined that in this matter to avoid any kind of confusion the column of stone in salient feature should be deleted. Accordingly the committee recommended to grant the terms of reference as earlier prescribed in 666th SEAC-1 meeting dated 21/06/2022"

There is a discrepancy in three basic documents viz. mine plan, mine plan approval letter and Lol thus refer the case to DGM for their opinion and accordingly modifying the related documents. Project be delisted till the corrected documents are submitted by PP / consultant.

13. Silica Sand Mining at Araj No./Plot No./Gata No.- part of 207 and part of 56, Village – Bankipur, Tehsil- Bara, District- Prayagraj, Smt. Santoshi Singh, M/s Maa Pitambara Traders, Area 23.50 ha. File No. 7130/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/77695/2022

This project was discussed in SEIAA meeting no. 632 dated 21.07.2022 where SEIAA opined as follows –

"SEIAA noted that SEAC-1 has recommended to issue Terms of reference to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that in MoM, proposed production/year of Silica sand is mentioned as 73,592 m³ /annum and of stone is mentioned as 49,062 m³ /annum whereas in LOI and mining plan approval letter proposed production /year of Silica sand is mentioned 73,592 m³ /annum only and there is no details regarding stone production. Hence SEIAA opined that show cause notice be issued to consultant along with copy to QCI & NABET and bring it to the notice of DGM. Proposal be referred back to SEAC-1 for re-evaluation."

SEAC-1 has recommended as follows –

"In view of above, the committee opined that in this matter to avoid any kind of confusion the column of stone in salient feature should be deleted. Accordingly the committee recommended to grant the terms of reference as earlier prescribed in 667th SEAC-1 meeting dated 22/06/2022"

There is a discrepancy in three basic documents viz. mine plan, mine plan approval letter and Lol thus refer the case to DGM for their opinion and accordingly modifying the related documents. Project be delisted till the corrected documents are submitted by PP / consultant.

14. Discussion on Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi order dated 04/07/2022 in the matter of OA No. 212/2021.

SEIAA took note of comments recorded by SEAC-1.

Agenda –B- Reply

1. Capacity Expansion of Sugar Mill from 11,000 TCD along with 55 MW Co-Generation Power Plant to 16,000 TCD along with 75 MW Co-Generation Power Plant at Ajbapur, P.O.
